Michele Neylon: you even

Jonathan Robinson: @Fadi - Is the board involved @ all or is it only management / staff next week?

David Olive: Thanks Jonathan I will reply this as Fadi

German Valdez: (Adobe Connect)

Susie Johnson: German, thank you. If you would like a call back from Adigo, please let me know.

German Valdez: Thanks Susie, so far audio quality is very good in my side (Australia)

Jonathan Robinson: Key question for Fadi. What can we do to help you? What do you need from us to support you especially in international forums?

Michele Neylon: we prefer direct

Jonathan Robinson: I have no microphone.

Michele Neylon: Jonathan - and this is a bad thing? :)

Michele Neylon: are we going to see screenshots of it or how will that work?

Jonathan Robinson: When you say we could be better aligned, do you feel we are misaligned or simply not yet aligned in working together?

Michele Neylon: Is Fadi aware of how much a mess the 1net mailing list has become?

Rafik: question to Fadi about his expectation from the cross-community working group

Patrik Fältström: 1Net mailing list is completely not usable

Rafik: working group of course

Patrik Fältström: Ok, I will ask

Michele Neylon: Patrik - I try to dip into it - it hurts my head

Rafik: @patrik @michele will eb glad to get your feedback on how to improve 1net

Bill Drake: Revenge of the old French left on 1net

Bill Drake: IG is the new American threat

Patrik Fältström: I think the major problem with 1Net is that there is lack of focus (what is the agenda, goal, means?) and lack of people that can moderate. i.e. just allowing anyone say whatever they want on a mailing list is not really constructive

Bill Drake: which, BTW, is probably particularly annoying to French colleagues

Rafik: @patrik an urgent task for the steering committee

Patrik Fältström: I know I have had similar questions on the CCWG on IG. Where Bill (thanks) agreed with me that THAT list probably should be used for discussion on how to improve ICANN.

David Olive: Bill Drake, then Patrik F and then OCL in the line for questions

Patrik Fältström: Thanks David.

Rafik: @patrik @bill all input are needed for the charter, I think that you already did and I hope that more will do

Louie Lee: I can go with whatever frequency the group desires. As for the time and day, it's 5am for me in Calif. So there's still little chance of a meeting conflict.

Patrik Fältström: For CCWG och IG, yes. You will get more input now when I think I understand what we are doing there ;-)

Rafik: @patrik charter is group efforts and you gave you input on that ;)

Michele Neylon: I *think* it might be a tad clearer now than it was a few weeks ago

Kristina Rosette: Don't forget the conspiracy theories, Patrik.

Bill Drake: I'm not really sure a charter would help

Michele Neylon: +1

David Olive: Thanks Louie on your comment on frequency and we would "rotate" times

Michele Neylon: to what Patrik

Michele Neylon: said

Michele Neylon: it's attracting all the worse trolls

Bill Drake: no, there are worse we have yet to hear from

Marie-laure Lemineur: @patrik +1

Alain Bidron: Patrick +1

Jonathan Robinson: Once per month for now is probably too infrequent. It seems that a lot will happen between now and Brasil

Michele Neylon: Aye

Michele Neylon: once every two weeks would be better

Michele Neylon: BUT

Michele Neylon: I need an alternate

Michele Neylon: ie. one of my other excom types to fill in if I can't make the call

Michele Neylon: as I need sleep and travel a lot

Kristina Rosette: Will the calls Theresa is mentioning be recorded and recordings made available?

Bill Drake: Theresa, I have not heard about a 1net SC call...

Patrik Fältström: I was hang up from the call.

Patrik Fältström: Susie, can you call me again? +46-8-56286024

Susie Johnson: Yes.

David Olive: Ok Patrik we will do it

Patrik Fältström: Regarding what Bill pointed out, that *ICANN* (neither staff, nor leadership, and specifically not Fadi) can fix the 1Net mailing list: I completely agree. I just wanted to flag for ICANN and Fadi that the mailing list is `_at_the_moment_` not useful.

Patrik Fältström: Thanks for reconnecting me btw. I am on the call again.

David Olive: Great Thanks

David Olive: Olivier is next

David Olive: Then Michele

David Olive: And then Kristina on her questions about INet discussions

Kristina Rosette: @David: Thanks. If I can rely on the chat, I'd appreciate it. My current location is quite loud so I'm on mute. Many thanks.

David Olive: Yes Kristina I will relate your question about INet discussion

David Olive: Byron you will be after Michele and Kristina

Bill Drake: Governments don't want to be part of 1net...

Michele Neylon: According to what I heard last night all the business places at that meeting have already been assigned

Michele Neylon: so the registrars / registries won't have a seat

Jonathan Robinson: @Olivier - Registries & Registrars also have a challenge as to where they fit in.

Olivier Crepin-Leblond: I absolutely agree with you Jonathan

Olivier Crepin-Leblond: Registrar/Registries, ccTLD operators, users, they're all missing from the equation

Patrik Fältström: I think we can only do either "stakeholder group" based discussions or "topic based". I am an optimist thinking that IF we get really focused discussions based on topics, it will be easier to look at the participation and drivers for each one of those individual issues.

Jonathan Robinson: Perhaps this is an area where ICANN can help? Articulating / explaining ICANN's structure, make-up and constituencies and expertise. Therefore need for specific voices.

Kristina Rosette: Thanks!

Bill Drake: Patrik, topical would be good, but in the constitutive phase the who sits where stuff inevitably will dominate, especially since many participants are not part of the ICANNsphere

Patrik Fältström: Bill, yes. I am of course pushing things in the extreme. I am just nervous we look "too much" on the stakeholder group issues and not as much on the topic issues. Specifically if we dead-lock, we should try to attack the problem from some other direction.

Kristina Rosette: Apologies. I need to stay on mute because of significant background noise.

David Olive: Kristina I will send you the link to the INEt archives of discussion
