

ATLAS II Mentors Guide

Activities should be developed by each Mentor and are distinguished in two stages:

a) Before the London meeting

b) During the London meeting

Following are the details of each stage:

a) Before the London meeting

We suggest each Mentor express in which language she/he is available/capable to do mentoring.

People who are committed to serve as Mentor will should complete the Wiki (<https://community.icann.org/display/atlarge/ATLAS+II+List+of+Mentors+and+Mentees>) with this information or send it to us to complete the Wiki.

When the list of ATLAS II Mentor is completed, this list with name of Mentors, group of Mentees assigned and languages on which they offered mentoring will be publishing in the Wiki created to the ATLAS II Mentoring Program (<https://community.icann.org/display/atlarge/ATLAS+II+List+of+Mentors+and+Mentees>)

From **May 19** we should send an email to each group of Mentors and Mentees to get in touch to the group and conduct the appropriate conversations/consultations.

We suggest each Mentor can find the best way or tool to communicate to each own group.

We suggest to each group can discuss about:

- Topics on which Mentees need mentoring, responding questions that each Mentees have.
- Thematic Session which will be take place on London meeting to each Mentor can guide the group to select the appropriate Thematic Session depending of their interests.
- How At-Large meetings work and how Mentees can participate and take advantage of them.
- General schedule of ICANN meeting to guide the Mentees to attend the sessions outside At-Large of their interest or expertise.

It is strongly suggested that from this first communication Mentors maintain contact and follow up with their own group.

b) During the London meeting

During the ATLAS II meeting that will take place on London we plan the following activities to Mentors:

1) Participants of the Mentoring Program (Mentors and Mentees) are invited to meet in London meeting on Saturday 21st June at 13:00 to 15:00.

We strongly suggest participants to meet in this space to meet each others, both Mentors and Mentees and their respective groups.

In this meeting will be participating Janice Douma Lange, ICANN Staff, to invite ATLAS II participants to attend the morning sessions of the Fellowship Program.

We also will distribute the elements to identify Mentors.

b) It will encourage to the groups of Mentors and Mentees who have created previously to the meeting, to have informal meetings in the meeting itself (at the time lunch, coffee breaks, dinner, etc.) for consultations, questions or comments that are necessary to perform.
