Workshop raising awareness on accessibility to the Internet for people with disability to participants at PacINET. Demonstrations of Internet use by members of the Cook Islands National Disability Council. This workshop will reflect the work of the newly formed At-Large Accessibility Taskforce.

Note that on average 15% of the population has a disability. According to WHO, one billion people have a disability globally with 80% in developing countries.

- Heightened awareness about APRALO and the At-Large Accessibility Taskforce by giving more visibility, credibility and trust to ICANN
- Awareness about the disability community and overcoming digital disadvantage.
- New organisational and/or individual input, participation or membership for At-Large and other ICANN constituent bodies.
