New from OCTO: Technical Analysis of New IP



The Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) has published a technical analysis of New IP, a concept that emerged recently in the context of technology battles, competition among standard bodies, and international geopolitics.

The document considers the New IP's relationship to Network 2030, a focus group created in 2018 by the

International Telecommunication Union. The publication also analyzes existing informal documentation to understand the concepts behind New IP, compatibility with the current Internet

Protocols (IPv4, IPv6), and the potential challenges of its deployment.

Look no further than the <u>Universal Acceptance Readiness Report FY20</u>, recently published by the Universal Acceptance Steering Group (UASG). The detailed report captures a summary of scope of UA, documents the current gaps in technology related to UA readiness to-date, and provides an overview of activities undertaken by the UASG in FY20 (July 2019 – June 2020).
