Singapore meeting: preparation, update from planning team

Proposal from Olivier posted in the list (with call minutes inserted in blue):

Two sessions:

- 1. Monday: Public session collecting input from the community
- 2. Wednesday: Face to face open session on the WG where we-ll discuss the information received at the public session, discuss the charter and probably the roadmap of where we go after Brazil.

A. TIME

The team felt that it was important to have the 10:30-12:30 slot on Monday, inmediatly after the Opening Ceremony. This time was originally the SO/AC Joint session and clashed with the least number of other sessions.

The proposed 1:30 hour 13:20-15:00 session as currently listed on the Master Schedule was deemed unsuitable because it clashes with the Name Collision session. Currently the 2:00 hour 10:30-12:00 slot is allocated to "ICANN globalization: Community Dialogue"

Marilyn: If we have too many, I propose to split it. But I don't think we will have.

Bill: Are we going to have these statements? Do we know how many there might be?

Olivier: We should put Community Statements – Comments.

Bill: I think we should then split those 10 minutes.

Filiz: The issue is not how many statements we will have but allocating mic time from the agenda. We could read their comments/suggestions; everybody has the same amount of time

Marilyn: we only have one so they accommodate it asking for the mic. I would propose not having a specific time for this and move it to the "questions to community".

Olivier: we will fold the Community statements in the Questions to community. My concern is that not many people will come to the mic. This is my experience with ATRT sessions.

Filiz: Change it to "Community input" rather than "Questions to community".

Bill: Isn't this going to be a free for all?

Marilyn: The point is to have an open-mic to listen.

Filiz: proposing a clock/timer, providing fair time and equal chance for all who wants to speak.

Marilyn: proposing a roving mic and that questions be printed out, not just posted.
