Changes Made in Response to Public Comment

- We reviewed all our Recommendations (36)
 - Clarified several **Recommendations**
 - Added new **Recommendation 23** (GNSO Council make-up) – *refer pages 91ff*
 - Strengthened **Recommendation 13** (Specific technology solution) – *refer pages 60ff*
- Re-grouped Recommendations within our **Four Themes**
 1. **Participation and Representation** (17)
 2. **Continuous Development** (11)
 3. **Transparency** (6)
 4. **Alignment with ICANN's Future** (2)

Changes Made in Response to Public Comment

We also ...

- Revised **Report Summary** (Section 1)
- Clarified **Methodology** (Section 3)
- Revised **Changing Environment** (Section 9)
 - Referencing ALAC 2012 White Paper – ‘***Making ICANN Relevant, Responsive & Respected***’
- Clarified several other parts of the Report, in response to **Public Comment** and **feedback** received at ICANN53, Buenos Aires

Measuring our Report's Effectiveness

- Part of our ToR asked us to comment on the effectiveness of previous review recommendations
 - Very hard to do, because few or no **Critical Success Factors** or **Measures** in previous reviews
- We have prepared a brief informal guidance document, '***Potential Indicators of Success***', for use by GNSO Review WP and ICANN staff
 - To develop and agree quantified success measures
