Notes

- In total, 123 people have started the survey; this number is up from 118 last week.
- Westlake noted that there are some groups that do not have a large showing. Specifically, the GAC (4 survey takers), ccNSO (3 survey takers), and SSAC (2 survey takers).
- The GNSO comprises half of the survey takers.
- Approximately 1/3 of the ICANN Board has completed the survey.
- There have been no surveys taken in Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian, or Spanish – surveys have only be taken in English.
- It was suggested and agreed that the survey would be extended through ICANN 51, ending 17-October-2014. This extension was made in an effort to ensure as much diverse participation as possible.

- It was decided that the Supplementary 360 Assessment survey would not launch until the original 360 Assessment survey was completed.
- Staff confirmed that they would work with the Communications Department in an effort to have the Review noted in the opening speech.
- Staff confirmed that they would work on promotional materials for the survey that could be handed out at the meeting.
- Westlake confirmed that they are working on an initial list of interviewees but that they would like input from the Working Party.
- Westlake confirmed that one aspect of their report would be the previous Recommendations made from the first GNSO Review. Westlake will look to see if these Recommendations were in fact implemented and, if so, what their effects on the GNSO were.
- Westlake confirmed that while the list of interviewees will be made public, the content of the discussions will be held confidential. In cases where interpretation takes place, Westlake will coordinate with ICANN Staff.
