- The GNSO Review Working Party reviewed the proposed 360 Assessment and provided feedback
 - Split questions into smaller components, including items 5 and 10 were discussed. I
 - Use simple and clear language.
 - Intended subject of the question – GNSO overall or each stakeholder group.
 - When one question depends on the answer to another question, reflect this relationship accordingly (such as questions 14 and 15).
- In terms of structure, the group decided that the survey should attract both those inside and outside of the GNSO.
- Group would think about a logical way to break the survey into components, to allow responders to complete manageable sections in one sitting

- The ability to stop responding, save one's work and come back to the survey later is essential.
- As the Group works through the software application and its functionality, it will explore exactly what tools are available to make this as user-friendly a survey as possible.
