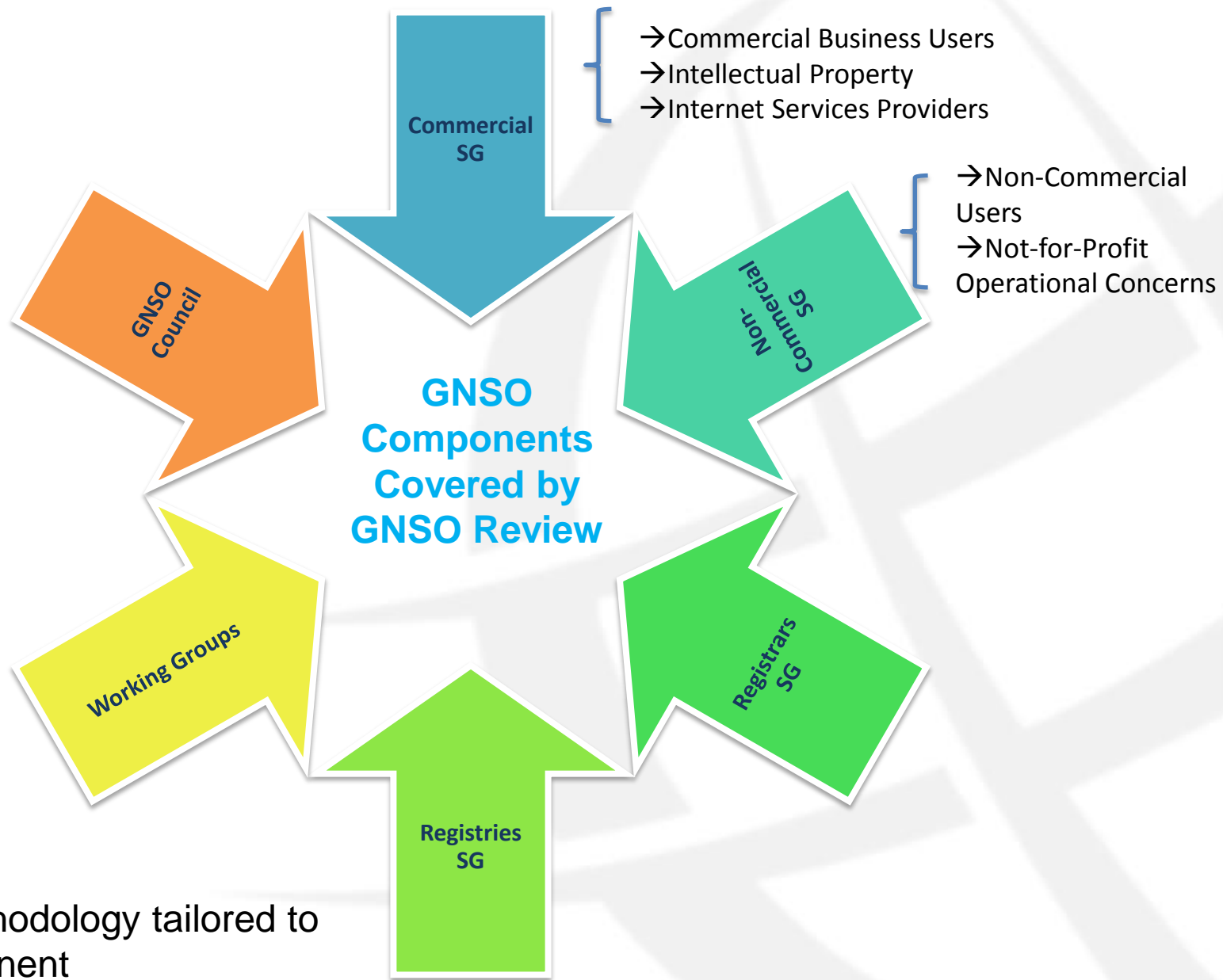

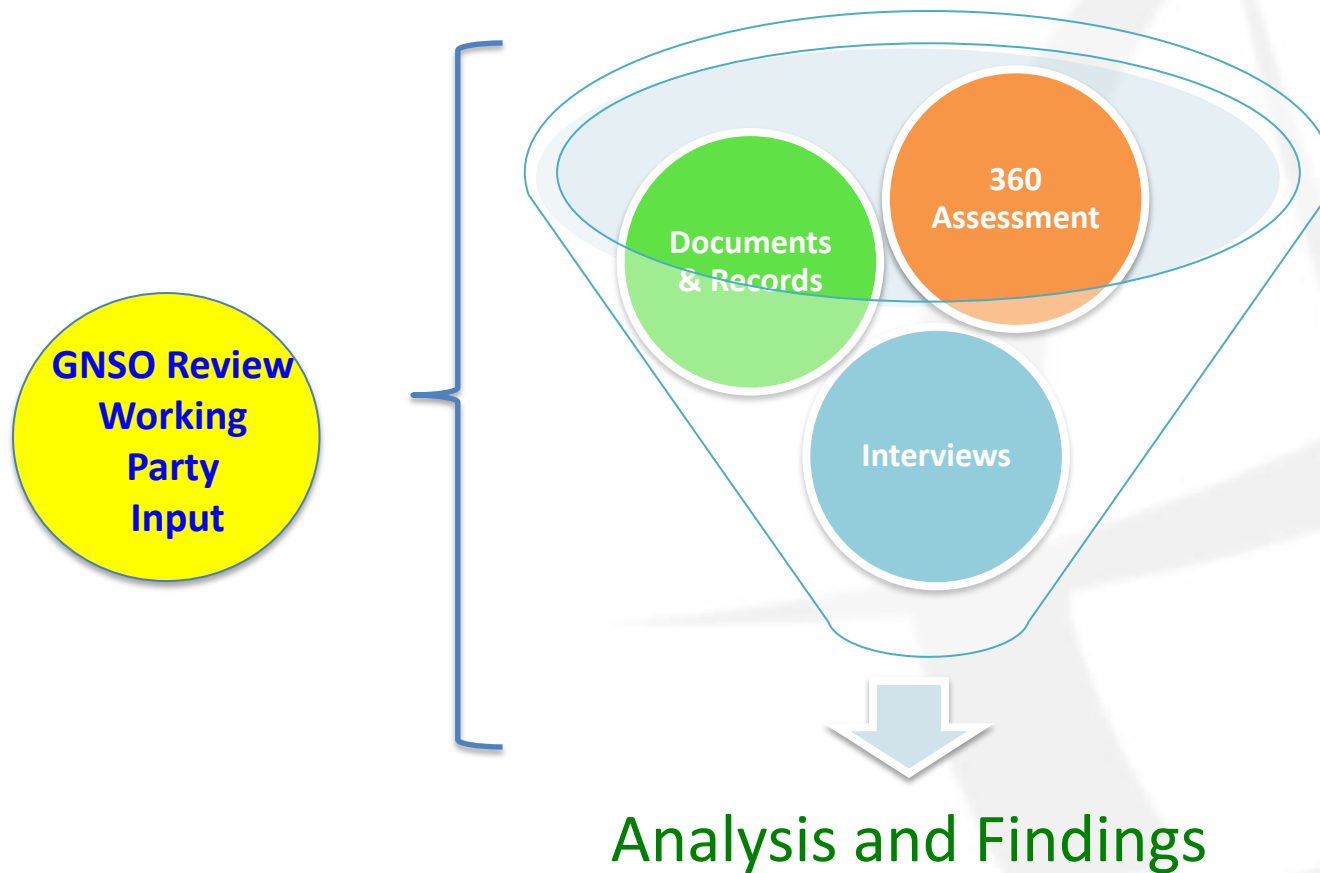
What is the GNSO Review?

- Review of the structure - Bylaws mandated
- Examine organizational effectiveness - GNSO and its structures
 - Prior Review's recommendations – implementation, impact, effectiveness (e.g. Working Groups)
 - Purpose and accountability
 - Organization and participation
 - Execution: getting the work done, outcomes
- New, improved approach to conducting reviews
 - 360 Assessment; GNSO Review Working Party

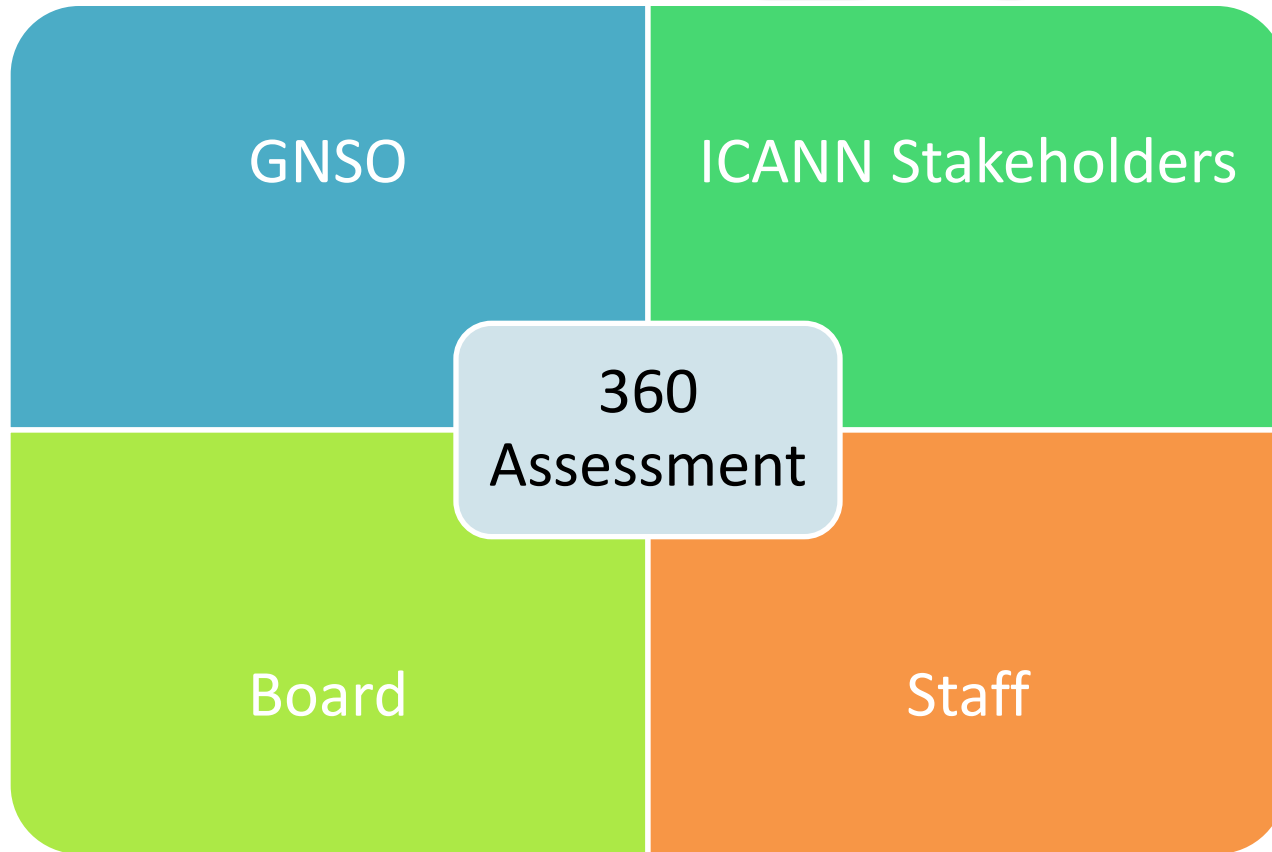

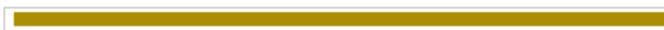

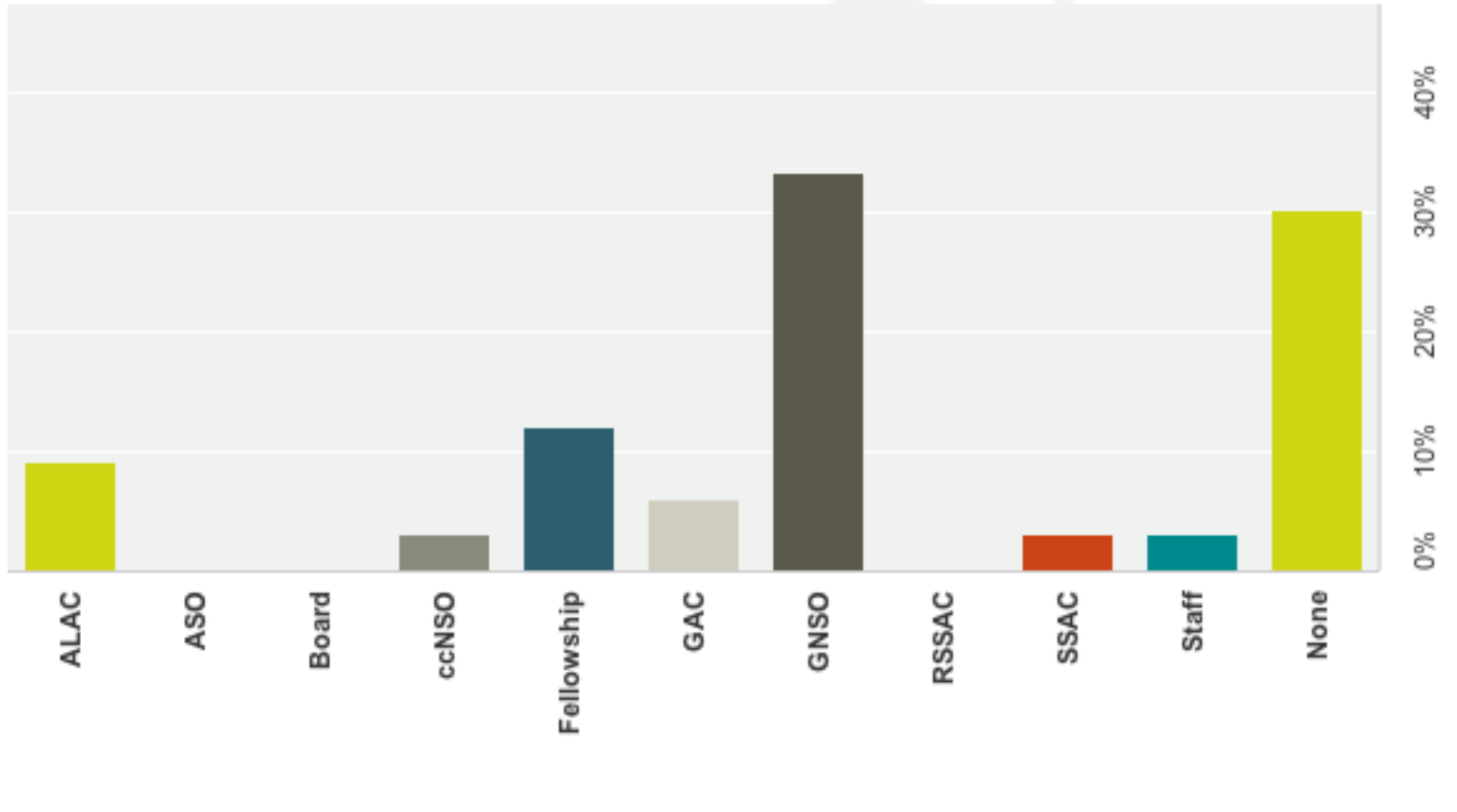
