## New gTLD Road Show

In support of efforts of industry partners, ICANN was present at the New gTLD road shows put up in Taipei, Hong Kong and Beijing. Special thanks go out to our industry friends who helped promote awareness and share information on brand protection in the domain name space. At the sessions in Taipei and Hong Kong, Kuek (VP, Asia) invited greater APAC participation in ICANN's policy process. Over 100 participants were at the sessions including major brands such as Hutchison, CSL, TVB and Alibaba.



In Beijing, there were also more than 100 attendees including New gTLD applicants, registrars, IP law firms, and domain name investors.

ICANN's Head of China, Song Zheng, stressed the importance ICANN attaches to China and the role of Beijing Engagement Center as a direct contact point to expand cooperation with Chinese stakeholders.

## Indian Center for DNS Security Announced at IMDEC



ICANN, in partnership with the Center for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), announced plans to create a Center of Excellence in Domain Name System Security in India.

The Center for Excellence will strive to solve critical Domain Name System (DNS) security issues by designing research projects together with ICANN security staff,

as well as house a state-of-the-art research laboratory to evaluate and test security solutions.

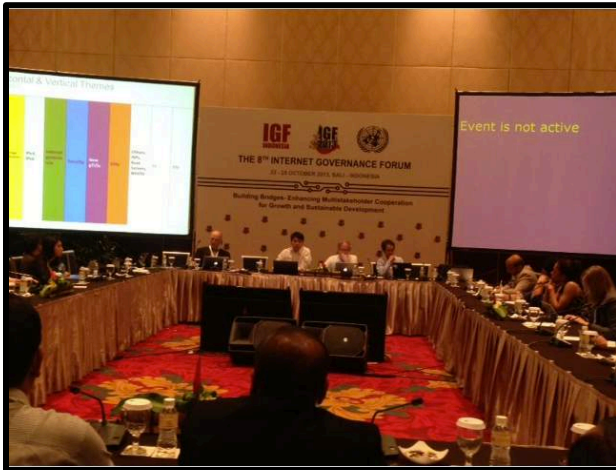
## NASSCOM-DSCI 8th Annual Information Security Summit (AISS) in New Delhi

The APAC region played host to the Global Internet Governance Forum this year. Held in Bali, Indonesia on 22 – 25<sup>th</sup> October, the 8<sup>th</sup> IGF was themed “Building Bridges – Enhancing Multi-

stakeholder Cooperation for Growth and Sustainable Development”.

The sub-themes are:

- Access and Diversity – Internet as an engine for growth and sustainable development.
- Openness – Human rights, freedom of expression and free flow of information on the Internet.
- Security – Legal and other Frameworks: Spam, Hacking and Cyber-crime.
- Principles of Multistakeholder Cooperation.
- Internet Governance Principles.

Macao community, but together with TWNIC and HKIRC as well. Jia-Rong Low (Head, Strategy & Initiatives) gave an opening speech on Internet governance. We would like to congratulate Macao for the successful hosting of its first IGF, and we continue to support the building of such dialogue in the region.

## ICANN 48 In Buenos Aires

Hosted by NIC Argentina in the Capital city Buenos Aires, the ICANN 48 Meeting held over 200 separate sessions in 5 days covering a myriad of topics from Internet Governance, New gTLDs and Security Updates, to Accountability and Transparency, IDN Variant TLDs followed by a Public Forum as well as the Public ICANN Board Meeting.
