The Asia Pacific Hub team participated at the APRICOT 2014 conference in Petaling Jaya, Malaysia (18-28 February 2014). A highlight for us was the organising of our pilot ICANN Update Session on 24 February 2014, in response to earlier feedback to bring ICANN's issues to the APAC community. The session was well-attended with almost 80 participants, with a number of fresh faces who have only heard from the APAC Hub the first time. We would like to thank you for your support in attending and for the lively discussion on our four main topics covering Universal Acceptance of all Top Level Domains;

Internationalised Domain Names (IDN) Variants; Refining and Replacing WHOIS; and Updates on the New gTLD Programme. Survey respondents at the session asked us to organise more of such events (we will!), and to continue to be kept in touch with the community (we will and hope that you could help link us up too!).

As of 28 February, 1 L-Root Single Nodes went live for Philippine Long Distance Telephone Company (PLDT)

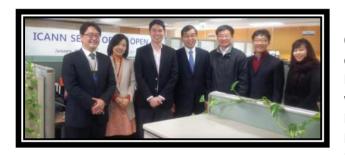
CHINESE NEW YEAR IN BEIJING WITH ICANN PRESIDENT





ICANN CEO and President Fadi Chehadé, together with Kuek Yu Chuang (Vice President of Asia) and Song Zheng (Head of China), paid a visit to Beijing in the midst of the Lunar New Year Festivities to meet with top government officials, industry partners and community stakeholders. Topics discussed included Internet Governance, New gTLD Program, IPv6 deployment, IDNs, internationalization and localization of ICANN. The next steps in cooperation with major Chinese stakeholders and support of the Chinese community's future participation of ICANN were also part of the dialogue to strengthen ICANN's partnership with the Chinese Internet Community.

In Beijing, Fadi communicated the importance of maintaining a single global Internet, as allowing the Internet to fragment would negatively impact the global economy and undermine public interests. Our community partners JPNIC (Japan Network Information Centre) and Internet Association Japan, organised a read-out session of the recent ICANN48 meeting to de-brief the Japanese community. JPRS (Japan Registry Service) provided an update on the Country Code Names Supporting Organisation (ccNSO) while Mr. Shuji Yamaguchi, Director for Global ICT Strategy, Ministry of Internal Affairs (MIC) and Communications, provided updates on the Governmental Advisory Committee (GAC). This was the first read-out session that took place since the opening of ICANN's Asia Pacific Hub and Kuek participated in strong support to promote and gather feedback on the Asia Pacific engagement strategy and also to provide clarification on certain Internet Governance issues.
