**Name:** John Crain

**Motivation:** I am interested in helping to improve the stability and resiliency in all areas of the Internet's Identifier systems and have a keen interest in the DNS specifically. I am very keen to see the operations of the higher levels of the DNS hierarchy become more transparent through enabling others to better understand the functioning of these systems. My belief is that RSSAC should be a key enabler in that area.
