- Version 6.1 for final draft
 - No additional change since the team review/ edit at the last IRT meeting on 11 October 2016
- This is the final IRT review planned. Barring any issues, this version will be used for Public Comment




Public Comment Readiness

- Complete IRT review and support of the of the draft consensus policy document
- Publish for Public Comment
 - Comment period to extend from October to November 2016
 - Period includes ICANN 57 Hyderabad
- Summary and Analysis Report following the Public Comment
- Finalize Consensus Policy Document with IRT Review
- Policy Announcement on 1 February 2017

Draft Memo to GNSO Council on Privacy

- First mentioned an IRT session in Helsinki
- IRT agreement: the implementation project proceeds in parallel to the memo drafting and subsequent submission to the GNSO Council
- Draft provided to IRT on 26 August 2016 by Marc Anderson
- IRT discussions continues
