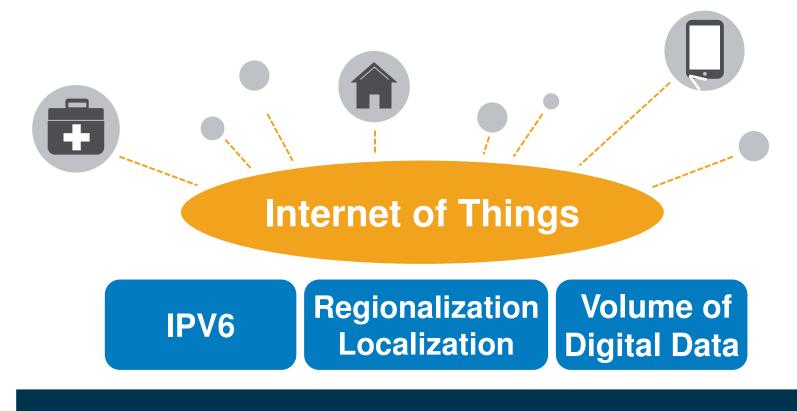


Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers

Scaling to Meet Change

- January May 2012: ICANN accepted New gTLD applications
- June 13, 2012: ICANN gTLD Reveal Day
 - $_{\circ}$ 1930 applications received for 1409 unique gTLD strings
- Behind the Numbers:
 - 116 Internationalized Domain Name applications (representing 12 different scripts)
 - 84 Community-based applications
 - 66 Geographic name applications
 - o ~ 600 .Brand Applications
 - 60 different countries and territories submitted applications

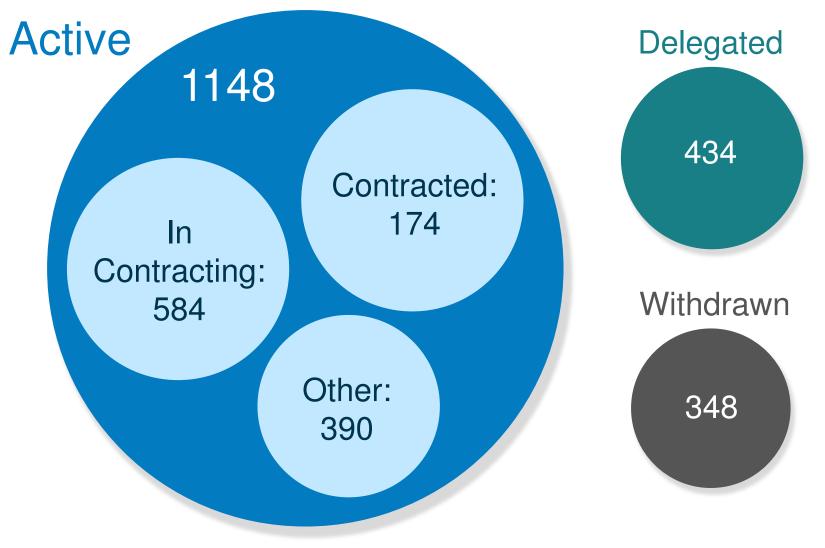

Program Progress – Applications

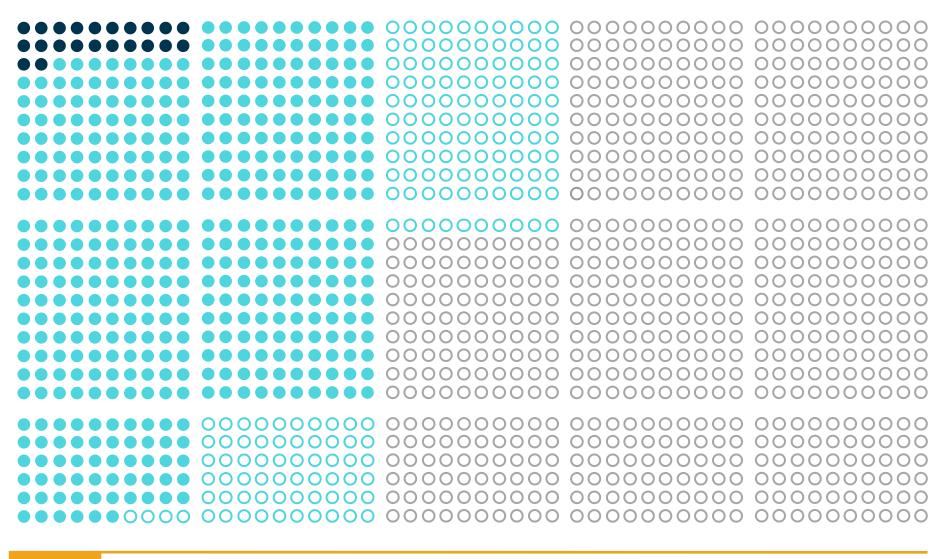




22 gTLDs delegated prior to October 2013
