avri doria: what did the staff evaluate on?

avri doria: you know this meeting is recorded. i do not know if any of the specifics about people was supposed to be confidential. just checking.

Amr Elsadr: I don't think any of this is supposed to be confidential. Not according to the new process.

avri doria: cool. that is great

Stephanie Perrin: my question is just on the premise of recusal for ethical reasons. I am sorry for the remark re surprise at certain people rating so high....since we don't know the ratings grid, I cannot make such a statement.

avri doria: OT: Obama just commuted Chelsea Manning's sentence - to be re;eased in May

Ayden Férdeline: just heard... great news @avri!!

Stephanie Perrin: Will Snowden be next?

matthew shears: not likely

Kathy: The Privacy Shield in the EU changes everything

Stephanie Perrin: Why?

Kathy: This work was all done before the Privacy Shield.

Stephanie Perrin: Not clear Privacy Shield will survive

avri doria: can commute his sentence as he was not yet tried and imprisoned. not a chance he will get any consideration.

avri doria: can't ...

avri doria: plus he is still messing about

Stephanie Perrin: I believe Marika is supposed to be coming up with a proposal for a new IRT on WHOIS conflicts

Kathy: Amr- are the Registries on board with this?

Kathy: Is Verisign on board with this they are the ones who are going to be receiving the data from European registrars.

Kathy: There are huge warnings in the US on data flows to/from Europe under the Privacy Shield.

Kathy: Ques in chat

Amr Elsadr: @Kathy: The registries are the ones who've been pushing for this. VeriSign specifically.

Kathy: I'm not on the call

Kathy: OK, tx

Amr Elsadr: Mainly Joe Waldman (I think that's his name) and Marc Anderson.

Kathy: Makes sense

Amr Elsadr: on the community budget requests, we're expecting a briefing from staff on this.

matthew shears: is there a schedule yet for NCSG and NCUC meetings?

matthew shears: at CPH

Tapani Tarvainen: schedule is being worked on, not ready yet

matthew shears: good idea Stephanie

Maryam Bakoshi: Yes I did

Stephanie Perrin: Thanks Maryam!

Maryam Bakoshi: Welcome, Stephanie

Kathy: and the waivers can't be applied easily by others -- if one registrar gets a waiver, another one right down the street still needs to get one too (with all of the same costs and time :-)

Amr Elsadr: Yes. Kathy. They hate going there.

Kathy: right

Amr Elsadr: @Stephanie: Yes..., that's what they're all saying.

Kathy: And again, massive warning meetings in the US.

Kathy: lots of new registration procedures for Privacy Shield compliance

Stephanie Perrin: not hearing anything....

matthew shears: should read the coments on that one - they say it all

Kathy: i'll be online in a sec

matthew shears: exactly Tapani

Amr Elsadr: There is a draft on the IRP. The PC should begin considering them soon.

matthew shears: YES Kathy !!!!!

Ayden Férdeline: total waste of resources writing that document

Amr Elsadr: Was dropped off the call. :(

avri doria: i sugges we send in a one line comment saying just that.

Kathy: :-) I'll be happy to draft!

Ines Hfaiedh: HI all

Sam Lanfranco, npoc/csih: Did only I lose the image?

matthew shears: sorry no mic - IRP one is important and deadline is 25th - see google doc that Farzi sent around for comments
