GNSO Working Session – update and discussion Saturday, 7 February ~10:30 am

Q1: Is the recommended PDP WG process being included in the current budget effort? Yes.

Q2: Is the recommendation for a single PDP WG, with parallel sub-WGs in phases 2-3? Yes.

Q3: Is phase 1 part of the PDP WG? What is the expected output of phase 1?

Phase 1 is where the PDP WG would start, by drafting foundational policy recommendations. Those recommendations would be reviewed and approved by the GNSO Council before continuing to phase 2.

Q4: What is the difference between phases 2 and 3? Are they iterative?

Phases 2 and 3 refine the policy recommendations established in phase 1, moving from "why" to "what" to "how." Phases 2 and 3 are likely to be iterative as the PDP WG examines how policies might be implemented and finds that some policy details need to be further refined.

Q5: How much time would the entire PDP WG or each phase take?
Unknown at this point. For example, phase 1 might last several months or a full year.

Q6: Are the areas addressed in phase 1 to be covered simultaneously? Yes.

Q7: What if the Council doesn't approve phase 1, or one of the areas cannot be completed? The recommended process gives the PDP WG a place to start, but is not a complete roadmap.

Q8: Does the EP-WG have any role during the recommended 3-phase process?

Unknown at this point, but the EP-WG may reconvene to review public comments on the Issue Report.

Q9: How will the feedback from this session be applied?

The EP-WG will consider and apply feedback from both the GNSO session and the All Things Whois session when formulating its final process recommendations.

Suggestions

S1: There should be a risk assessment first, before phase 1, based on the Preliminary Issue Report. Note: The EP-WG recommendations include developing input on both benefits and risks.

S2: The GAC and Data Protection officials should get involved early on, as part of the PDP WG. Note: It is standard procedure to call for PDP WG participation from all SOs/ACs.

S3: Given complexity, the GAC, SSAC, and external experts may be needed in some areas/phases.
