## Sequencing of EWG RDS Principles as input to GNSO PDP (Draft 2)

The flow charts that follow suggest grouping and sequencing of principles contained in the EWG's Final Report on a proposed Next-Generation Registration Directory Service (RDS).

These charts identify a three-phase PDP process consisting of:

Phase 1) Policy - Requirements Definition (WHY)

Phase 2) Policy – Functional Design (WHAT)


Phase 3) Implementation Guidance (Guidance on HOW)


where the PDP WG would examine all RDS policy requirements at a high level in Phase 1 before proceeding to Phase 2.

Upon entering Phase 2, opportunities for parallel policy design exist. Letters reflect interdependencies and sequencing (e.g., group C policies must be based upon group B policies).

Phase 3 then dives more deeply into each policy group, creating implementation guidance. Note that details considered in Phase 3 may require refinement of certain policies drafted during Phase 2; these two phases are therefore depicted as iterative.

Once Phase 3 is completed, PDP WG outputs feed into the next steps detailed on page 5 (e.g., PDP WG implementation guidance factored into IRT & Staff implementation efforts).


