










Q1. How is the timing of the webinar?








Q2: How is the technology used for the webinar?








Q3: Did the speakers demonstrate mastery of the topic?








Q4: Are you satisfied with the webinar?





Participation Rate

Dramatic improvement in the amount of feedback provided by webinar attendees



Success

Choices of speakers and technology used in the webinars have rendered success in general

Pop-Quiz vs. Evaluation

Audience participated more in popquiz than in evaluation survey; factors may include webinar length, repetition of questions, timing, etc.



Correlations

Satisfcation of the webinar is most positively correlated to speakers' mastery of topics; technology comes second; timing is not as important



Timing

Both 13:00 UTC and 20:00 UTC starting times work for the great majority of audience, although 13:00 UTC seems to perform better



Pop-Quiz Accuracy Rate

Pop-quiz accuracy rates may reflect audience's level of engagement in the webinar, but no clear correlation can be drawn
