Gustavo Paiva:In my experience appealing to values isn't terribly effective when dealing with law enforcement/government staff since they depend so much on hierarchies, which weaken values arguments.

Gustavo Paiva:I have one idea but I'm not sure how correct it is.

Gustavo Paiva:Trademark lawyers might specifically want this data in open formats, to facilitate development of applications to facilitate their work.

gangadhar panday 2:what currencies - in this what does 'currency' refer to?

Gustavo Paiva:In my experience what Law Enforcement wants above everything else is having hassle-free access to information. Blanket access is the means by which they want to achieve it.

Gustavo Paiva:Good partnerships with LE can be made if you keep that in mind. Even if you can't provide them blanket access you can look for other benefits they may want.
