SAMPLE TRIAGE OF IANA FUNCTIONS CONTRACT¹

The current IANA functions contract represents the responsibilities that ICANN/IANA has undertaken to perform in its contract with the NTIA. These individual contract terms should be assessed to determine:

- A. Which provisions should be retained in a future arrangement to which NTIA will not be a party;
- B. Which are specific to US government contracting practices and need not be retained;
- C. Which might need to be strengthened or enhanced to reflect the absence of overall NTIA stewardship, and
- D. Which may have a clear link to oversight and accountability.
- E. Out of Scope for CWG

The provisions below represent <u>examples</u> of provisions in the existing contract that may fall into each of these four categories. A more complete triage can be undertaken once there is agreement on this initial categorization.
