Objectives FY16


Build on pilots / ad hoc run so far And in partnership with our communities

- 1. A structured approach: To develop plan in time for rollout at the ICANN54 meeting
- **2. Tailored content and communications:** To assess existing and if necessary develop tailored content for use with civil society audiences, both online and face to face activities
- **3. Engagement activities:** both at global and regional levels, own events + engagement in CS event in each main region, and at each ICANN meeting
- **4. Capacity building:** assessment of existing capacity building, learning and related programmes, and as necessary, devise a roadmap to either enhance or put in place such programmes, including to support our communities' own outreach efforts
