Monika Zalnieriute:Hi! Monika Zalnieriute:11 pm

Monika Zalnieriute:yes, I was in fact ready to sleep

Monika Zalnieriute:thats fine:)

Monika Zalnieriute:once in a while, so hopefully not too often!

Robin Gross: Is there a proposed agenda?

Robin Gross: I think recusal is a good idea given the appeal is against Tapani's handling of the election

Robin Gross: Not present, only recusal from Tapani handling the appeal.

Robin Gross:ok

Maryam Bakoshi:Ponceletwe canthear you Maryam Bakoshi:Do you wanta dial out

Maryam Bakoshi:?

Monika Zalnieriute:Poncelet, we do not hear You

Maryam Bakoshi:we can hear you

Maryam Bakoshi:please clor your browdser

Maryam Bakoshi:\*browser

Maryam Bakoshi:and re-enter the room

Poncelet lleleji: I wanted to ask what options after excluding Tapani based on conflict of Interest as Robin mentioned

Monika Zalnieriute:Ok, its all good, apologies accepted.

Maryam Bakoshi:Poncelet please send me your numner

Maryam Bakoshi:its important for us tohear you properly

Monika Zalnieriute: We have some info to be forwarded from Bill, as per Tapani's request:

Monika Zalnieriute:should I share here?

Robin Gross:myhand is up

Monika Zalnieriute: Aha, so I will copy paste it here

Monika Zalnieriute:let Robin speak now

Monika Zalnieriute:Bill Drake: HiThis discussion has gotten a little overheated and hydra-headed with stuff being thrown into the pot that distracts from the single issue in contention. Let's not over-dramatize this, we're not at war with each other, we don't need to throw up our hands or rewrite the whole NCSG charter because of this, etc. We just have a collegial disagreement on one thing, which is the interpretation of NOTA, and how this is determined, and we ought to be able to work it out together. Tapani's dig through list archives was helpful, but a narrow reading of a few messages obscures more than enlightens. But in same message, she also agreed with Dan that NOTA "gets treated as a kind of additional candidate itself," and that, "Voting for 'none of the above' is explicit and is counted." Simila

Maryam Bakoshi: Monika if its a PDF you can upload it

Monika Zalnieriute:mhm, perhaps I could simply send it onto our NCSG EC list?

Monika Zalnieriute:its not a PDF, its an e-mail

Maryam Bakoshi:ok... could you make it into a PDF?

Robin Gross: Tapani is wrong. There is an appeal on the table and must be dealt with pursuant to the charter rules.

Monika Zalnieriute:mhm, I have shared it on our NCSG EC list just now

Tapani Tarvainen: I don't think that is clear that the appeal is valid, but I don't insist on deciding it now.

Monika Zalnieriute:Indeed it was Tapani who called the meeting to deal with the appeal.

Tapani Tarvainen:Of course. We have to deal with any appeal presented without prejudging its validity.

Poncelet lleleji: I will be grateful to know how we should consider that appeal what suggestions should be made, the elections is already on so

Monika Zalnieriute:I fully support Robin that appeal must be taken into account, and we now are dealing with it. Bill (silent observer):2.1 The NCSG chair is responsible for carrying out the executive functions of the NCSG under the NCSG-EC's oversight according to ICANN, GNSO and NCSG mission and principles.2.4.2. By default NCSGEC decisions are made by full consensus of all NCSGEC members. Full consensus means that no NCSGEC members have objected to the proposed decision. Any exception to this default will be approved by the NCSGEC on a full consensus basis.4.2 All NCSG votes will be held using an online voting system to be determined, approved and supervised by the NCSGEC

Bill (silent observer):the above rules were violated

Monika Zalnieriute:Ok, people are entitled to hold different opinions (and clearly they do so even as to facts, and rules), and it seems that there will be no consensus on this. What we are looking for is some sort fo a greement that would be acceptable to most of our NCSG members.

Robin Gross: myhand is up

Tapani Tarvainen: mine is up too

Poncelet lleleji 2:So can we work towards a consensus we going round and round

Bill (silent observer): I did the same thing Robin last year and my ballot was counted too

Monika Zalnieriute: But NOTA is should count as a vote, is that not correct?

Bill (silent observer): NOTA was counted as a vote by the software

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Monika Zalnieriute:So in fact it is counted as a VOTE then.

Bill (silent observer): Yes, again, the software counts as we have interpreted it

Bill (silent observer): One would have to affirmatively change the way the software works to do what Tapani is saving

Monika Zalnieriute: It seems the system is the same.

Monika Zalnieriute: So in such case, we need a solution on interpretation, correct?

Bill (silent observer): Joan are you saying observers are not allowed to type in the chat?

Tapani Tarvainen: Agreed.

Poncelet lleleji 2:Agreed

Robin Gross:yes, we need to talk to Glen

Monika Zalnieriute: Agreed.

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Monika Zalnieriute: I can check that.

Robin Gross: this should be the entire committee

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, entire committee.

Poncelet Ileleji 2: Tapani sends an Email to Glen and copies EC

Robin Gross:ok

Robin Gross: what poncelet suggests

Monika Zalnieriute: E-mail should be enought.

Tapani Tarvainen: OK, I'll do that.

Poncelet lleleji 2:Yes after the email then we met again

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, lets discuss options towards concensus.

Poncelet lleleji 2:Once we get clarity from Glen's email then we can move on

Monika Zalnieriute: I tend to agree that we have options either way, irrespective of what Glen replies.

Monika Zalnieriute:So I see no reason to wait.

Monika Zalnieriute:Rovin's hand is up.

Poncelet lleleji 2:But Monika the options in a way are related to what Glen says

Monika Zalnieriute:Sorry, typo.

Monika Zalnieriute:Robin's hand up

Poncelet lleleji 2:I will prefer that

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, we can.

Tapani Tarvainen: Agreed on improving process for next year.

Poncelet Ileleji 2:Agreed

Monika Zalnieriute: And please clarify - people who voted - they still can go and change it during the elections?

Monika Zalnieriute:as this is IMPORTANT, if we continue with these ballots

Monika Zalnieriute:we need to clarify!

Poncelet lleleji 2:Making it clear will be all votes counted, as per last year scenario

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Poncelet lleleji 2:But we need that clarity from Glen

Monika Zalnieriute: Can someone clarify if people can MODIFY their votes?

Maryam Bakoshi:@Monika:Yes

Monika Zalnieriute: I support Robin's view, and this would allow to move forward.

Marvam Bakoshi:the last vote will not count

Poncelet Ileleji 2:I dont think you can modify your vote after voting Monika its a democratic process

Monika Zalnieriute: So this means, we simply need to make sure this is COMMUNICATED to people.

Robin Gross:votes can be changed until the vote is ended. only the last vote count

Robin Gross: the charter does guide us

Poncelet lleleii 2:thanks for clarityh robin

Robin Gross: I'll tell you where in the charter when I am caled on

Robin Gross:called on

Poncelet Ileleji 2:K

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up...

Monika Zalnieriute: Disagree with Poncelet.

Monika Zalnieriute:But Tapani, we need to somehow move on now - or we are going to postpone things as much as we can?

Monika Zalnieriute: In my view, its a compromise, cause in fact people are calling for new elections.

Poncelet lleleji 2:Monika I want to base my judgement on getting clarity from Glen

Robin Gross:myhand is up

Maryam Bakoshi:Glen is available to anwer questions

Maryam Bakoshi:Do we want her to come in the meeting?

Monika Zalnieriute: So this would be a compromise, cause You want to keep the elections this way, and the appeal wants to re-run the election. So that would be a compromise.

Monika Zalnieriute: Maryam, is there a way to dial Glen in?

Poncelet lleleii 2: If she can be dialed in fine

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes. please, we do want Glen./

Maryam Bakoshi:yes she will be in 5 mins

Monika Zalnieriute:No, I did not:)

Maryam Bakoshi: Thank you all for your patiene. She would be loggin in shortly

Monika Zalnieriute: I am typing only.

Maryam Bakoshi:\*patience

Joan Kerr:@Monika:ok

James Gannon (Silent Observer): Im sorry I wasnt going to speak but this is a distraction, it is NOT the issue on the table. Please disucss the issue on the table.

Monika Zalnieriute: I think it became clear that there are 2 different opinions, and Robin expressed very clearly the arguments on behalf of the appellant. It is for us now, as EC committee, to demosntrate some leadership bylooking for solutions. I dont see why we keep saying these are merely opinions, and interpretations. Ok, even if so. We need a solution, and not simply deny and negate each others views.

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Tapani Tarvainen: US elections aren't democracy?

Monika Zalnieriute:Indeed, going into philosophical discussions are not gonna solve our immediate problem, yes?

Maryam Bakoshi:Glen is on the bridge

Maryam Bakoshi: She can speak now

Monika Zalnieriute:So while I might have my personal views, which others may disagree with, but now we need decide if /how we can move forward from this disagreement.

Monika Zalnieriute: Sorry, Glen, what happens if one only selects 2 candidates and does not tick NOTA at all?

Poncelet lleleji 2:Thanks Glen its very clear to me

Tapani Tarvainen: That kind of ballot would be invalid, I think.

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, I agree, should be invcalid.

Monika Zalnieriute:But can Glen clarify whats the role of NOTA if its not ticked?

Monika Zalnieriute:No, in democracy people are allowed to invalidate their ballots, yes.

Monika Zalnieriute: So why should we force them to return valid allots, this is forcing people.

Monika Zalnieriute: Glen, what happens if one only selects 2 candidates and does not tick NOTA at all?

Monika Zalnieriute:no, I did not ask about validity, but simply what its counted

Robin Gross:Good to hear from Glen that votes are not invalided by voting for NOTA and a candidate. That is the practice we assumed.

Monika Zalnieriute:No, it does not answer myquestion.

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Monika Zalnieriute:yes!

Monika Zalnieriute:yes, that I understand, but we care about numbers of candidates vs NOTA

Monika Zalnieriute: numbers of votes of particular candidate vs NOTA

Monika Zalnieriute: Thats what I heard. So e.g, I voted 2 candidates out of 3, and I did not tick NOTA. Whats the effect of this for that 1 candidate for whom I did not vote.

Tapani Tarvainen: Then NOTA gets fewer votes.

Monika Zalnieriute: Cause this is differnet if I vote 2 and NOTA.

Tapani Tarvainen: Yes.

Tapani Tarvainen: That's the point of being able to vote NOTA or not.

Monika Zalnieriute:So this implies that I need to vote NOTA as well if I dont want to get a particular candidate through. Correct?

Tapani Tarvainen: That's to be decided.

Robin Gross: Disagree, Tapani, Votes count.

James Gannon (Silent Observer): And if they tick NOTA their count for the 3 candidates is also counted correct?

Monika Zalnieriute: We cant ask people to REDO.

Poncelet lleleji 2:Thanks Glen is very clear

Robin Gross: I think they should be encouraged to vote.

Robin Gross:not invalided.

Monika Zalnieriute: I mean, in real life people have a right to INVALIDATE ballots

Monika Zalnieriute:intentionally

Monika Zalnieriute: yes, they should be encouraged, but not forced

Monika Zalnieriute:so we encourgae by inviting

Monika Zalnieriute:but not forcing to tick coprrectly

Poncelet lleleji 2: You cant force someone definitely Monika

Robin Gross: Agree.

James Gannon (Silent Observer): Can someone please get 100% confirmation that if NOTA is ticked along with 2 candidates all 2 votes are counted

Robin Gross: lasked and shed confirmed they count.

Monika Zalnieriute: Well, and even if we wanted - we don't have such powers to force people.

Poncelet lleleii 2:They all count

Monika Zalnieriute: So only in case if NOTA is ticked alongs de ALL the candidates, it becomes INVALID, correct?

Tapani Tarvainen: That's my understanding.

Monika Zalnieriute:Can others confirm?

Monika Zalnieriute:So if our understanding is the same or at least similar - then we are reaching towards concensus.

Monika Zalnieriute: Is understanding similar - Tapani?

Monika Zalnieriute: So lets discuss it perhaps.

Monika Zalnieriute:Sorry, but there was no DISAGREEMENT now!!!

Monika Zalnieriute: Tapani only said now, we did not yet agree concensus on what could we do with NOTA winning.

Monika Zalnieriute: Shall we discuss that?

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, so lets reach the concensus what do we do.

Monika Zalnieriute:We are all in agreement now.

Monika Zalnieriute:Lets discuss NOTA winning - what do we do then?

Poncelet Ileleji 2: The Consensus all Votes count as explained by Glen, we take precedence from last elections, except their is something else I dont understand

Poncelet lleleji 2:there i mean

Monika Zalnieriute:Ok, we have 1 proposal from Robin, if NOTA wins, then we, as EC appoint the candidate.

Monika Zalnieriute:Robin, but I think we agreed on that already.

Monika Zalnieriute: I thought we only deal with trying to establish a clear thing what do we do if NOTA wins.

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, it seems we agree.

Monika Zalnieriute: So please do not argue over that again.

Monika Zalnieriute: Simple question:

Monika Zalnieriute:if NOTA wins - whats the procedure how do we put someone in its place - this is OUR QUESTION

Monika Zalnieriute:yes, please, lets prepare

Monika Zalnieriute:So Robin's proposal is that we as EC decide whi fills NOTA's seat.

Tapani Tarvainen: It is n't written down anywhere.

James Gannon (Silent Observer): GNSO OPerating Procedures work in that manner

Tapani Tarvainen: And there have been different interpretations.

Bill (silent observer):yes, yours and everyone else's

Monika Zalnieriute: We agreed on this, Poncelet, lets now analyze HOW we fill that seat.

Monika Zalnieriute:please, colleagues, we have 1 question in front of us: how we fill the seat of NOTA?

Tapani Tarvainen:hand up

Monika Zalnieriute: Sorry, who disagrees with NOTA winning?

Monika Zalnieriute:who disagrees?

Monika Zalnieriute:So Joan agrees.

Monika Zalnieriute:Does Tapani agree????

Monika Zalnieriute:Please answer here, and please lets move on specifics,

Tapani Tarvainen: No. But I will recuse myself from the decision.

Monika Zalnieriute:its approachinh 1 am for me, please colleagues

Monika Zalnieriute:so then: let me summarise and clarify: NOTA wins then,

Monika Zalnieriute:others have expressed their approval

Monika Zalnieriute: NOTA winning?

Monika Zalnieriute: Please specifcy Tapani - You disagree with NOTA winning, correct?

Tapani Tarvainen: Yes.

Monika Zalnieriute: Whywe go back again? Joan?

Monika Zalnieriute: We, as EC have now expressed our opinion - we all support NOTA winning, is that correct?

Monika Zalnieriute:Sorry, guys, I think we all made a decision.

Monika Zalnieriute: And I cannot accept talking the same and the same.

Tapani Tarvainen: Joan, please make a formal motion to decide this.

Monika Zalnieriute: Everyone, except Tapani, agreed that NOTA wins.

Monika Zalnieriute:Lets move on from here.

Monika Zalnieriute: Sorry, 1.5 hours simply for this.

Monika Zalnieriute: Please: lets finish this. Everyone expressed their views.

Monika Zalnieriute:Me too.

Monika Zalnieriute:So it was only Tapani against.

Monika Zalnieriute: Previously.

Monika Zalnieriute: Joan, could You please read the chat as well?

Monika Zalnieriute:Yes.

Poncelet Ileleii 2:Yes

Monika Zalnieriute:Poncelet has already said that.

Monika Zalnieriute:Yes!!!!!!!

Monika Zalnieriute: How many times.

Monika Zalnieriute:So lets define it!!!!

Monika Zalnieriute: Sorry, Joan, guestion one by one.

James Gannon (Silent Observer): Yes or No

Monika Zalnieriute: So You agree or disagree now with NOTA.

Monika Zalnieriute:Yes or No, Joan.

Monika Zalnieriute:Please, this is just way too much, I will leave the call

Tapani Tarvainen: Filling vacancies in this case is a bit unclear but the EC can decide it in a number of ways.

Monika Zalnieriute:cause in fact You keep talking the same things during mysleeping hours/.

Monika Zalnieriute:Please VOTE

Monika Zalnieriute:yes or no

Monika Zalnieriute: Sorry, Joan, its too much.

Monika Zalnieriute: Finished.

Monika Zalnieriute: Thank You.

James Gannon (Silent Observer): Thank you all

Monika Zalnieriute: So now - we still have not decided how do we fill NOTA?

Tapani Tarvainen: So decision is (1) continue with current ballot (2) allow voting for NOTA with 1-2 candidates (3)

anybody with less votes than NOTA won't get elected?

James Gannon (Silent Observer):Correct

Poncelet lleleji 2:Agreed

Monika Zalnieriute: Yes, but HOW we fill in the NOTA seat?

Monika Zalnieriute:so this will be left for the future?

Monika Zalnieriute:Ok, this sounds good:)

Farzaneh Badii (observer):can observers saythank you and bye?

Monika Zalnieriute::)

Bill (silent observer):and NOTA does NOT cancel other votes

Monika Zalnieriute:ok, so the only question remaining is vacant slot:)

Monika Zalnieriute:Wonderful!

Bill (silent observer):Monika it's highly unlikely there will be a vacant slot

Monika Zalnieriute: Bye bye!

Monika Zalnieriute:Ok, great!

Robin Gross:bye!

Robin Gross:thanks!

Monika Zalnieriute: Thank You!!!!

Monika Zalnieriute: It was great!
