



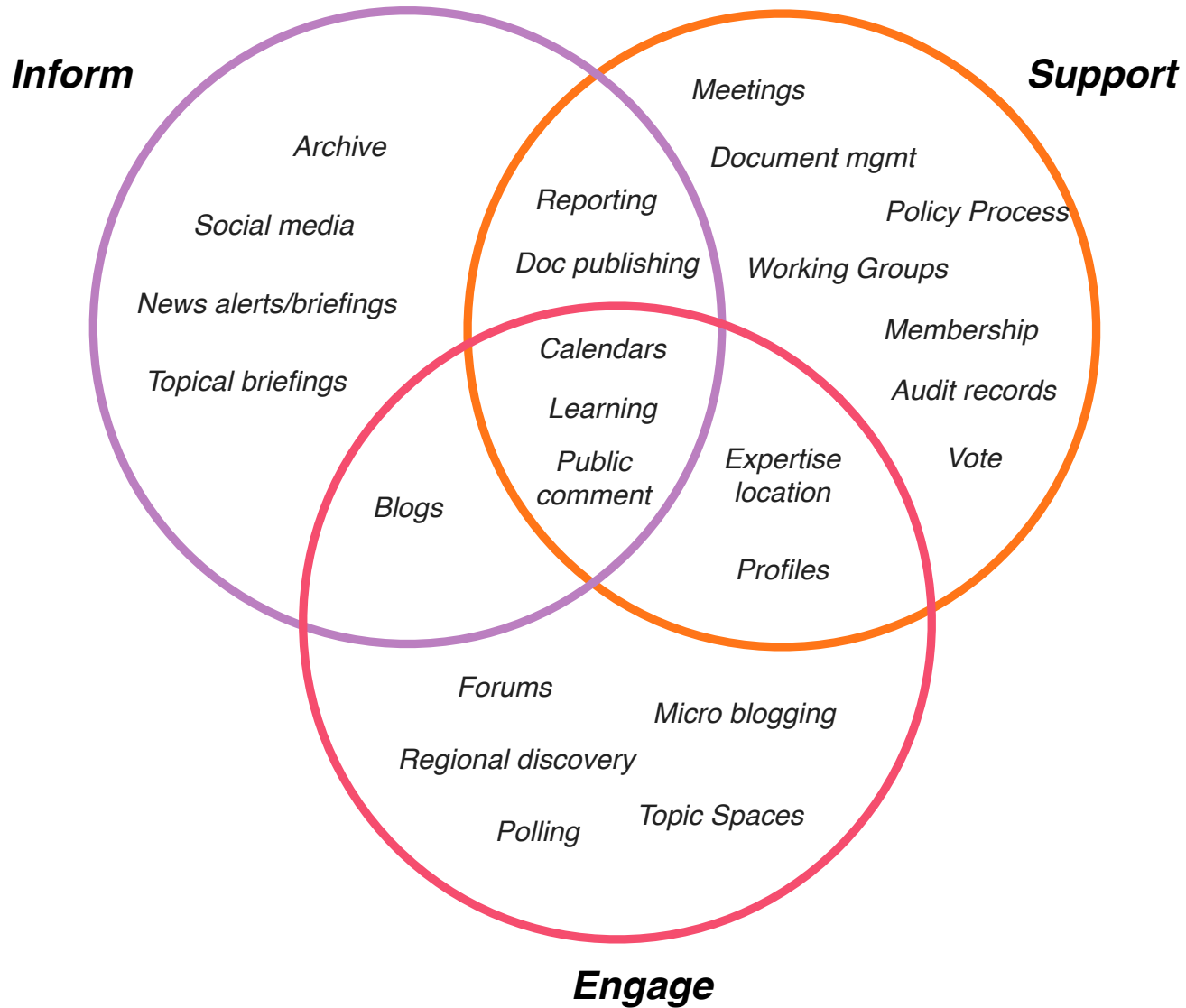

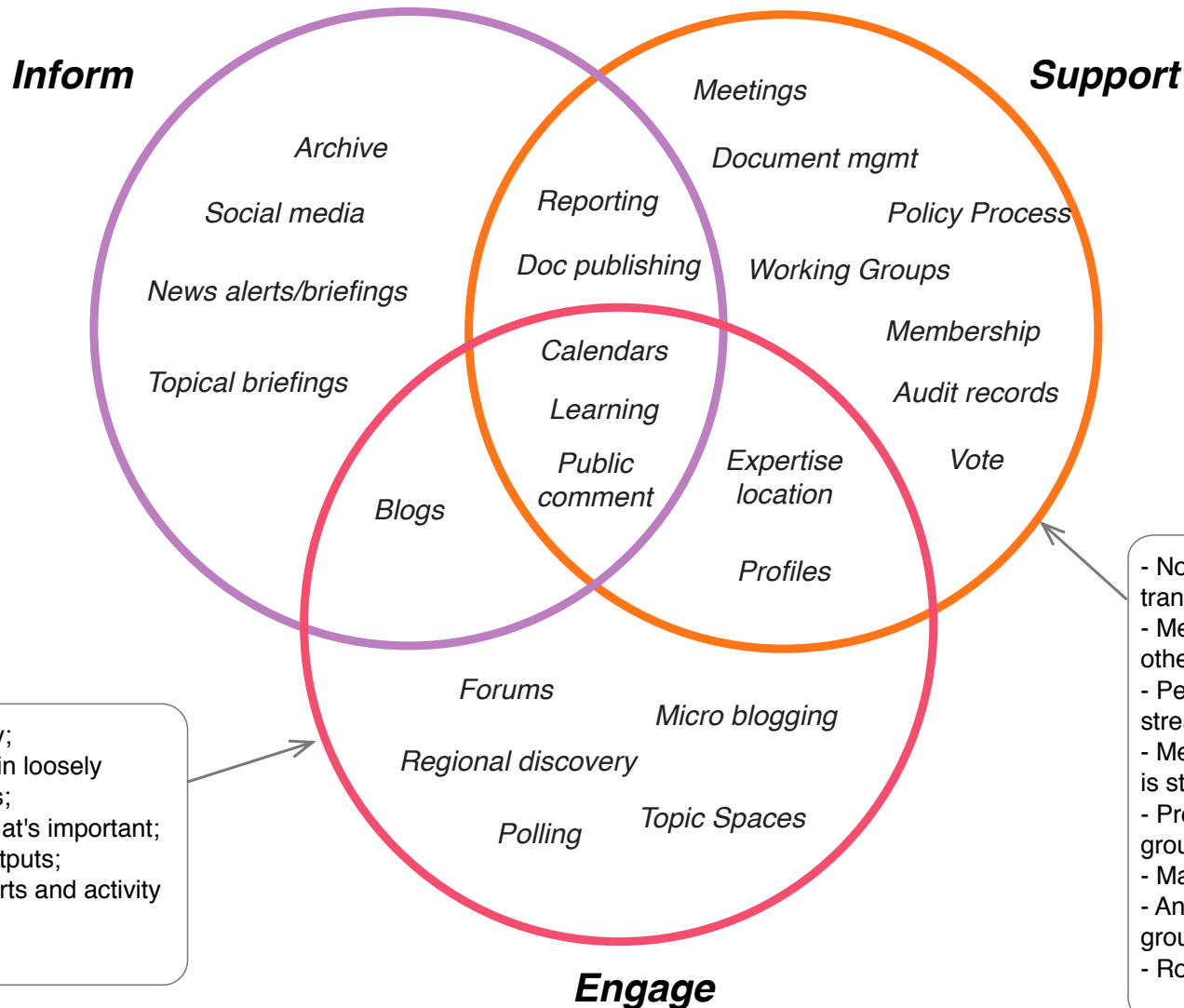
# Constraints / Opportunities

- ICANN is comprised of a wide spectrum of stakeholders in terms of:
  - How they access our sites
  - How comfortable they are with technology
  - What they want or willing to do online
- Our individual and group needs are diverse;
- There are few organizational standards, processes, or work methods;
- Individuals and groups like to use their apps of choice (or mandated by their parent organization);
- We live in a rapidly evolving technology services landscape;
- ICANN is undergoing fundamental change
- We have limited resources.

# Our Services View – Circa FY14



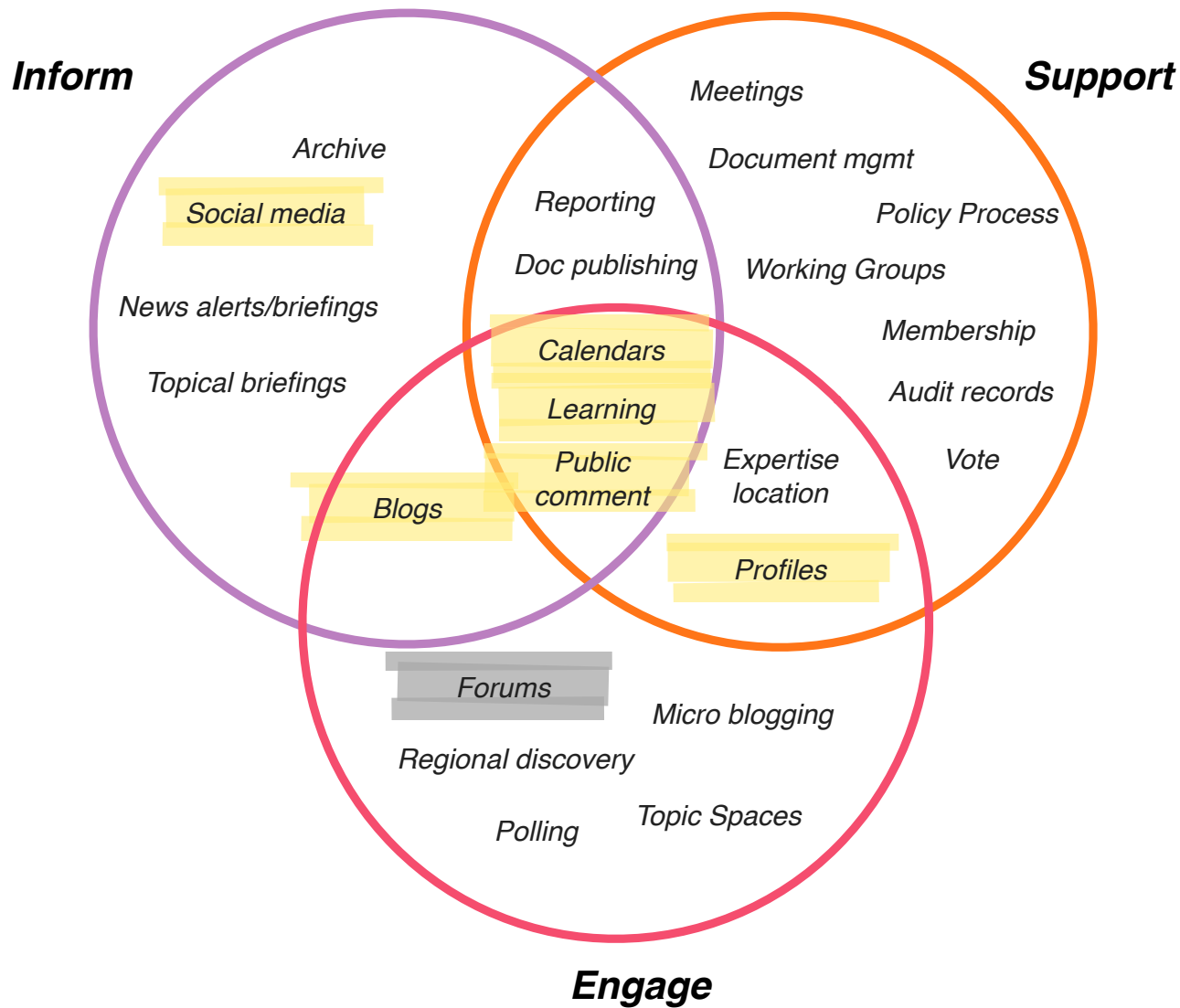
# Our Services View – User Interactions



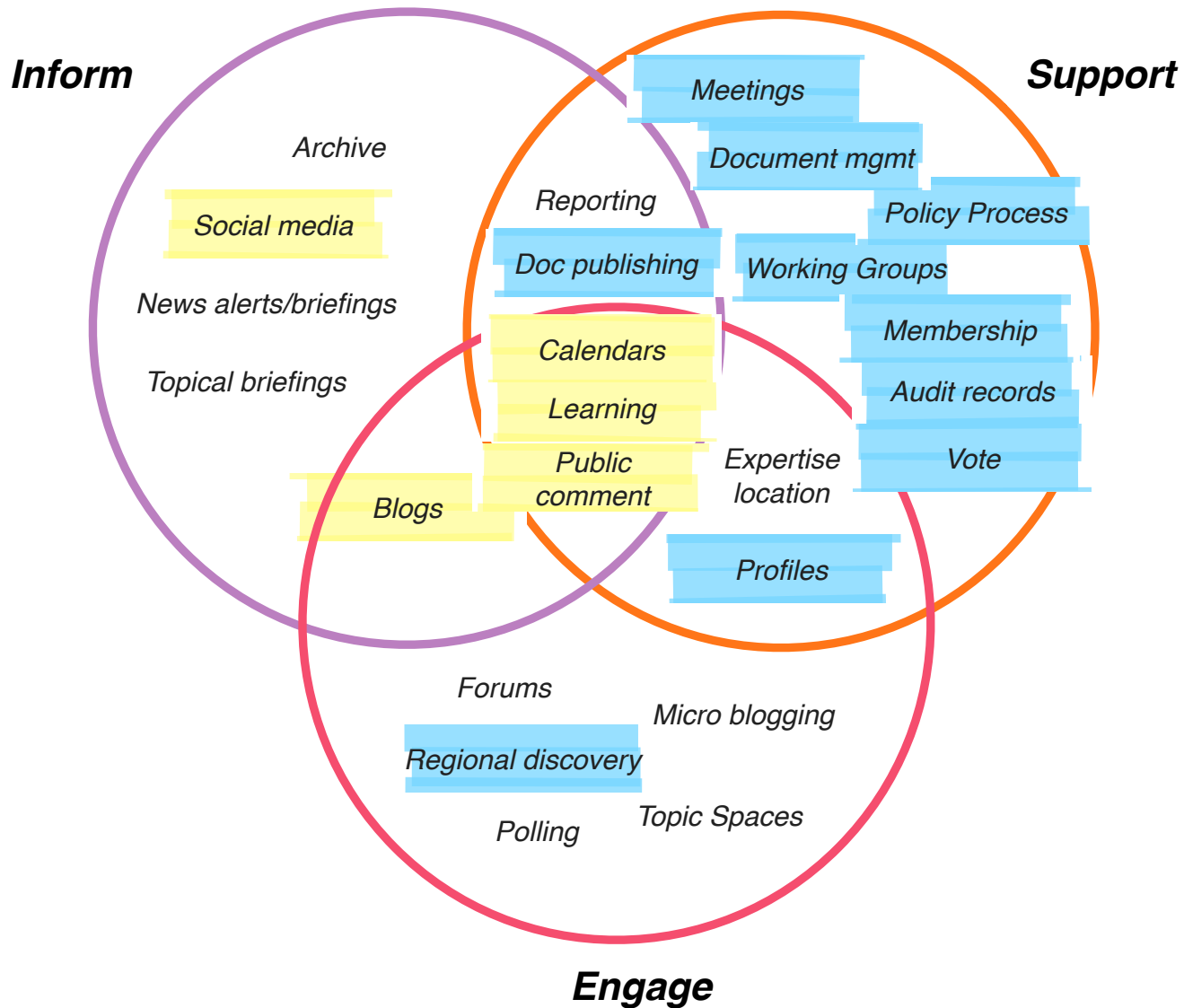
- The site is sticky;

# 18 Month Vision

- Identify and strengthen people/volunteer journeys

- Join the Open Data movement



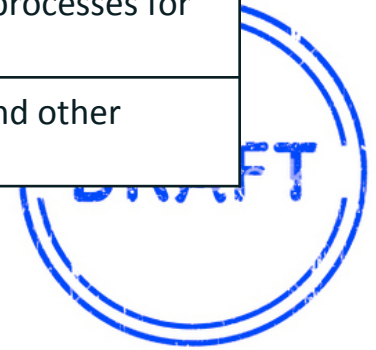
# FY16 Draft Projects List

Name	Description
Re-configure resources section/ CMS	The Resources section of ICANN.org contains the bulk of the website content, and the content most used by participants. It is poorly organized and confusing.
Collaborative document authoring	A new service for working groups and committees to improve document authoring processes
Working management	A new service to reduce the administrative workload with managing working groups
Stakeholder management	Services to automate administrative management of stakeholder and constituency membership
Single Sign On (SSO)	A single point of authentication for all digital services
Newsfeeds	Aggregate all the various newsfeeds and newsletters (including myICANN) into a more coherent service.
New SO-AC websites	GAC, At Large, ccNSO, GNSO
Web 'CROPP' Program	Support for SG+C websites
Activity funnels	Mapping and implementing new comer funnels for digital engagement

Meeting app + site	Deployment of new Meetings website (plus the mobile app if not already deployed).
