Meeting Notes

The WP discussed the following agenda items:

- 1. Proposal for Latin Script RZ-LGR.** The Latin GP chair proposed the initial structure of the document on the Google doc. Moving forward, The WG should focus on developing the document. The LGR XML file can be generated within one or two weeks after the proposal document finalization. The GP discussed the following points.
 - The GP discussed the readiness of the input for the proposal and aimed to get the draft proposal before the face to face meeting in January 2018.
 - The Cyrillic RZ-LGR is undergoing public comment. Dennis will share the Latin-Cyrillic cross-script variant list by 1 December 2017. Then the Latin GP will submit it as a comment to Cyrillic RZ-LGR before 6 December 2017.
 - ICANN staff went through the Cyrillic RZ-LGR proposal with the GP, as a potential case for Latin GP to follow.
 - It was raised that the IP is working on the MSR-3 and plans to publish it for the public comment on 15 January 2018. If there are any code points the Latin GP thinks should be included in the MSR, the Latin GP should submit its input to the IP by 15 December 2017.
 - The GP discussed and agreed to have ICANN intern convert the references to numbers as needed for the LGR proposal.
- 2. Next meeting.** The WG concluded the meeting time at 1600UCT due to the poll. The WG agreed that the next meeting will be on 19 December 2017.
