### Meeting Notes

The GP discussed the following agenda items:

- 1. Short report on the Repertoire Group.** Mats updated the ongoing tasks:
  - a. The candidate code points for MSR-3. Mats and Mirjana are working on the candidate code points for MSR-3 and it is likely to have two candidate code points.
  - b. The analysis of languages with EGIDS-5. Meikal is working on it.
  - c. Mats will update the detail of Principles, as requested by the IP.

The public comment for Cyrillic LGR proposal is online, the GP is invited to submit some comments. One of the possible comments is the similar issue of the '02BC'. Cyrillic LGR proposal has the appendix for details of how the Cyrillic GP reached the conclusion not to include 02BC. the Latin GP discussed that it might be useful to add an appendix for the cases of '02BC' as well as other marks, especially for the 'click' sound.

Meikal is working on the list of problems found during processing of languages with EGIDS 1-4, but it could take some time due to the lack of or inconclusive references.

- 2. Short report on the Variant Group.** Dennis informed that the group is working on incorporating IP feedback received offline and from ICANN meeting into the analysis. They also conducted a cross-script analysis with Cyrillic and found seven code points that look identical with Cyrillic code points. The Variant Group will prepare the comment for the Cyrillic LGR proposal currently in public comment.
- 3. Initial work on drafting the LGR proposal.** The GP agreed to setup a Drafting Group to work on the proposal. The meeting time should be suitable for all people in the Drafting group. The output is two documents, the proposal and the machine-readable (XML). When the document proposal is ready, the XML file can be generated within a few days.
- 4. Next meetings.** The GP agreed on 12 December 2017. For the proposed code points in MSR-3, the GP can submit these through an email. It should include the reason for adding, the language being supported, its EGIDS of the language, and other useful references.
