**Meeting Notes**

The GP members discussed the Stability Issue: Locale-dependent Case folding Latin Small Letter Dotless I [document](#). The following table was discussed. The ‘Uppercase Input’ used Capital I with the dot to imitate the Turkish locale. The results showed instable A-labels.

**U-Label to A-Label examples, using Upper and Lower**

Turkish Label Unicode	Uppercase input	A-Label	Lowercase input	A-Label
zil	ZİL	xn--zil-9dc	zil	zil
binbaşı	BİNBAŞI	xn--binbaı-0jb205a	binbaşı	xn--binba-r4a53a

The instable A-label caused by the decomposition of the Capital I with the dot.

The Capital Letter Dotted I (0130) is case-folded to a sequence of Small Letter I (0069) and Combining Dot Above (0307).

It was agreed that more test was needed on the Turkish locale machine. The GP would provide a test case. ICANN staff would reach out to its Istanbul office for conducting the test.

The GP revisited **Section D.4.21 Stacking in Courier New (And Perhaps Other Fonts)**. It was confirmed that diacritic shifting problem was a bug in the font and would not warrant any variants.

The GP were asked to review the finalized [in-script analysis sheet](#). It was planned to be confirmed in the next meeting.
