### Meeting Notes

1. Michael, Bill, and Dennis reported the summary of the meeting with IP during ICANN64 as follows:
  - a. It is not possible to include the Middle Dot in the LGR to support “l·l” (letter L + Middle Dot + letter L) for Catalan language. This is because the middle dot has IDA2008 property as CONTEXTO which is not allowed by the LGR Procedure.
  - b. IP informed that the IP cannot make any decision on the variant set on behalf of the GP. It can only review the proposed proposal and respond. The IP requested GP to share the updated proposal to move forward.
2. The GP discussed the Variant Discovery Analysis from Mirjana, Bill, and Michael. The following pairs were identified for further visual analysis. The analysis from Hazem has not been discussed. The GP agreed to continue to discuss and finalize online.
