 - b. The cases of Dot below and Comma below for underlining analysis.
 - c. The case of Acute above and Dot above gemination for LATIN SMALL LETTER DOTLESS I (U+0131) and LATIN SMALL LETTER I (U+0069).
 - d. LATIN SMALL LETTER AE (U+00E6) and a sequence of a and e.
 - e. LATIN SMALL LIGATURE OE (U+0153) and a sequence o and e.
 - f. LATIN SMALL LETTER AE (U+00E6) and SMALL LIGATURE OE (U+0153)
 - g. å 1EA9 and åå 00E2 + 1EA3
 - h. é 1EC3 and êé 00EA + 1EBB
 - i. 6 1ED5 and 6 00F4 + 1ECF
