Tatiana Tropina:I agree with Matthew that applicability is a very big issue that should be analysed carefully

Tatiana Tropina:Now I can speak

matthew:yes +1 to transparency focus as well

Tatiana Tropina:yes, transparency - something that should be developed further

Alexandra Kulikova:Also very much interested in trasparency reporting point, hope people had a chnace to look at the doc I shared

Tatiana Tropina:Niels, we can use this standard but we have to see carefully what is applicable and what is not

matthew:perhaps we position the need to address HR as a part of corporate social responsibility but we don't need to build that piece out as that is a corporate responsibility - we can position our work on HR as a contribution to the eventual creation of CSR at ICANN

Tatiana Tropina:Matthew this sounds good

Tatiana Tropina:but we have to be clear about this

Niels ten Oever:+100

Avri Doria:but the principles are just guideline not a precise blueprint. would be problematic to ignore them.

Marilia Maciel:Whatever discussion on Dublin should be left to workstream 2, or we will never move fwd in wks1. It is better not to include the discussion of which particular documents would be the reference. List the potential ones, ok, but not pick them.

Marilia Maciel:Whatever discussion on Ruggie, sorry

Rafik:I think CSR was always about framing the topic, since talking about HR in general freak out many people in the community

Rafik:saying creating CSR can freaking out more

matthew:I am not against applying Ruggie principles I just feel that we need to explain carefully how they apply

Tatiana Tropina:+1 Matthew

Tatiana Tropina:My hand is lowered now :)

Tatiana Tropina:Avri, it was more about report recommendations. Not make HR dependent on the adoption of CSR policy as a whole

matthew:the first element of it I would say

Tatiana Tropina:First part I believe.

Tatiana Tropina:Good question Avri.

matthew:yes, agree Avri

Tatiana Tropina:absolutely agree Avri

Tatiana Tropina:I raised this issue only because of the report recommendation :)

Tatiana Tropina:Ruggie principles can be a red rag, I am not against them, but we should refer to them carefully (after discussion at the WP4)

matthew:yes and the cisco csr approach is a useful one in that context

Tatiana Tropina:not in the way it was mentioned in the document

matthew:agree with Marilia (it is even more difficult in ICANN than HR)

Rafik:a public interest discussion is planned within ICANN (not clear about the process). so yes better to not conflate

Tatiana Tropina:+ 1 to Marilia

Marilia Maciel:Rafik, would like to do it?

Rafik:nope,

Tatiana Tropina:I think a stress test will bring a possibility for all those guys to bring up the issue of lawsuits :(  
Marilia Maciel:Which document?  
Tatiana Tropina:Summary of public consultation comments?  
Tatiana Tropina:I mean the document  
Marilia Maciel:Staff read it out  
Marilia Maciel:I don't believe it is online. We can ask them  
Tatiana Tropina:oh. Thanks Marilia. I will listen to the call recording then :)  
matthew:a geographic gtld that is awarded to a corp thereby undermining the rights of indigenous persons to use the gtld for realizing their rights and therefore contrary to ICANN's commitment to HR?  
Marilia Maciel:It is part of the summary they are making of the whole of topics in the public consultation.  
Marilia Maciel:Which right, Matthew? Cultural?  
matthew:association, expression - them not having the tld might inhibit those rights - don't know - thinking out loud  
Marilia Maciel:The fact of not having rights there protects ICANN from these claims?  
Tatiana Tropina:Marilia :) + 1  
matthew:interesting to know if any has challenged the award/auction of tld based on HR considerations  
matthew:I suspect they have  
Rafik:@matt I don't recall such case happened  
matthew:ICANN Board view on inclusion of HR in bylaws: While the Board is committed to upholding human rights as appropriate within its Mission, the inclusion of human rights in the ICANN

Bylaws is premature at this time.

Tatiana Tropina:Matthew, O\_o.

Avri Doria:yes, that view by the Board is a real blocking problem.

nigel hickson:Good afternoon; am sure that re-delegation of a ccTLD could indeed raise HR and global public interest. They have in past
