UDRP Locking

- Intended to help prevent cyberflight--
 - Rr must lock registrar & registration data w/in 2 business days of notice from UDRP provider
 - Eliminates Complainants' req't to serve Respondent
- Becomes Effective 31 July 2015

Additional Whois Information Policy ("AWIP")

(IRTP B Rec 8 + IRTP C Rec 3)

- Adds new Whois output requirements for Rrs & Rys
 - Use only EPP status codes
 - Provide link to definitions @ icann.org
 - Requires Rys to publish GURIDs (Registrars' IANA IDs)
- Effective 31 January 2016
 - Many contracted parties are voluntarily complying early



Change of Registrant Policy (IRTP C Recs 1 & 2)

- Intended to help prevent domain hijacking
 - Rrs must obtain consent from New and Prior Rts during Change of Rt process
 - Inter-registrar transfers blocked for 60 days following change to Rt (unless Rt opted out of the lock)
 - Form of Authorization to expire after 60 days
- Staff working with IRT to consider public comments received a few more weeks of discussion likely required before rules finalized

Thick Whois

- Will require all registries to provide consistent, "thick" Whois output; called for review of potential legal issues
- IRT meeting Wed, 24 June 17:00 (Retiro B) to discuss legal issues memo & implications of finalization of RDAP protocol



IGO/INGO

• Call for volunteers for Implementation Review Team to go out shortly after ICANN53

IRTP D

- Amendments to Transfer Dispute Resolution Policy to, *inter alia*, enhance reporting by providers & ICANN, extend the "statute of limitations" to 12 months, eliminate the registry as a forum for dispute resolution
- Recommended formation of GNSO Council-convened panel to collect data & review the efficacy of the series of amendments to the IRTP

Privacy / Proxy Accreditation

 GDD staff monitoring progress of PPSAI WG and feeding input back to group in coordination with Policy staff
