Status Update

⊙ WG aiming to complete Initial Report before ICANN54 (Oct 2015)

- Recommendations will focus only on IGOs (not INGOs)
- Key questions in WG Charter whether existing processes (UDRP, URS) should be modified (and if so in what way) or if a new process narrowly tailored to IGOs should be developed

⊙ Current work status creates some potential delicate issues

- WG preliminary conclusion on *standing to file a complaint* differs somewhat from GAC general recommendation for IGO protections:
 - WG: IGO must have acted to protect itself pursuant to Paris Convention
 - GAC: IGO included on 2013 GAC List (using .int criteria)
- But more problematic issue likely to be *IGO immunity*:
 - International law unsettled (no single uniform rule across jurisdictions)
 - GAC has provided general input; none yet received from IGOs on this topic



Next Steps

- WG will continue to engage with the GAC (via GNSO Liaison) and IGO representatives to ensure full understanding of public policy and international law issues
- WG plans to consult international law expert on the accuracy of WG's research and findings so far on IGO immunity
- WG aims to prepare Initial Report for public comment before the Dublin meeting (ICANN54)
