Status Update

- ⦿ Initial Report published for public comment 5 May 2015:
 - ⦿ Contains key preliminary recommendations & several open questions
 - ⦿ Comments close 7 July 2015
- ⦿ Key preliminary recommendations:
 - ⦿ No need to distinguish between privacy & proxy services (for accreditation)
 - ⦿ Minimum mandatory published terms of service
 - ⦿ Designated contact point for reporting abuse (to TEAC standard in IRTP)
 - ⦿ Initial handling of Relay requests in electronic form, including what happens in event of persistent delivery failure
 - ⦿ Definitions for Disclosure & Publication (two aspects of Reveal)
 - ⦿ Specifying consequences of Disclosure/Publication to customers
 - ⦿ Illustrative Disclosure framework for IP requests

Open Questions

- ◉ Whether domain names registered for purposes associated with online financial transactions can use P/P services
 - ◉ Currently WG is divided (two additional statements filed in Initial Report)
- ◉ Escalation of relay requests following initial forwarding of an electronic request
 - ◉ No consensus yet on whether/how provider should/must forward further notices (and in what form – postal? Electronic? Any?)
 - ◉ No consensus yet on charging of [reasonable] cost-recovery fee
- ◉ Remaining questions on Disclosure & Publication
 - ◉ How to handle requests from third parties other than IP owners (e.g. LEA)
 - ◉ Whether Publication should be mandatory for malware & illegal activity
 - ◉ Remedies for unwarranted Publication

Next Steps

- ◉ WG will review all public comments received in preparing Final Report
- ◉ Final Report anticipated for submission in **Sept/Oct 2015**
- ◉ Implementation will need to begin as soon as possible (assuming approval from GNSO Council & ICANN Board)
 - ◉ Current interim P/P specification in 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement expires 1 January 2017
