


New since ICANN53

- Updated <u>Rights Protection Mechanisms Review</u> (incorporating public comments) published 11 Sep 15
- Draft <u>Program Implementation Review</u> published 23 Sep 15
 - Open for public comment until 7 Dec 2015
- Phase 1 of Registrant Survey published 25 Sep 15
- Phase 1 of economic study on competition in DNS published 28 Sep 15
 - Open for public comment until 7 Nov 15
- <u>Call for Volunteers</u> for CCT Review Team published 1 Oct 15
 - Open for submissions until 30 Oct 15
- Currently completing RFP processes to retain qualified providers to conduct <u>Trademark Clearinghouse Independent Review</u> and <u>Root Stability Study</u>




Policy Implementation Pipeline: Framework

IRTP C Implementation Update

IRTP C Change of Registrant Policy + FOA Expiration

Key policy changes:

- Registrars obtain consent from New and Prior Registrants during Change of Registrant process
- Inter-registrar transfers blocked for 60 days following change to Registrant (unless Registrant opted out of the lock)
- Form of Authorization to expire after 60 days

Announced 24 September 2015 Effective 1 August 2016



IRTP D Implementation Update

IRTP D

Amendments to Transfer Dispute Resolution Policy

Key policy changes:

- enhance reporting by providers & ICANN
- extend the TDRP statute of limitations to 12 mos.
- eliminate registry-level TDRP dispute resolution

Additionally:

GNSO Council-convened panel to review efficacy IRTP amendments

Current Status:

- IRT has met and discussed all policy changes
- Proposed TDRP and Transfer Policy amendments submitted for public comment shortly after ICANN54



Thick Whois Policy Implementation

Background

- Policy Recommendations adopted by the ICANN Board on 7 February 2014 http://www.icann.org/en/groups/board/documents/resolutions-07feb14-en.htm#2.c
- Two expected outcomes (policy recommendation #1)
 - Transition from thin to thick WHOIS for .COM, .NET and .JOBS
 - Consistent labeling and display for all gTLDs per Spec 3 RAA 2013
- Decoupling of implementation of the two outcomes in line with Implementation Considerations (Final Report of Thick WHOIS PDP)



Thick Whois Policy Implementation

Status of Consistent Labeling & Display for all gTLDs (CL&D)

- Staff completed an Impact Assessment, reviewed by the IRT
- Staff and IRT agreed on synchronization of Implementation with RDAP
- Staff will discuss Consensus Policy Language with IRT during ICANN 54
- Policy Effective date (current assumption): 1 February 2017

Status of Transition from thin to thick for .COM, .NET & .JOBS

- Staff released the Legal Review Memo on 8 June 2015 (Review of Law Applicable to the Transition of Data from a Thin to Thick Model)
- Staff has started consulting with the IRT and Experts from Affected Parties on implementation details
- Staff is currently drafting implementation proposals for further discussion



IGO/INGO Identifiers Protection Policy Implementation

Background

- Recommendations adopted in part by the ICANN Board on 30 April 2014 https://www.icann.org/resources/board-material/resolutions-2014-04-30-en#2.a
- Current effort focusing on implementation of protections at top and second level for:
 - Red Cross Red Crescent Movement Scope 1 identifiers
 - IOC Identifiers
 - IGOs Scope 1 Identifiers (Full Names)
 - INGOs Identifiers (ECOSOC General and Consultative Lists)
- Other GNSO Recommendation are part of the reconciliation effort underway between the Board, the GAC and the GNSO.



IGO/INGO Identifiers Protection Policy Implementation

Current Status

- Staff has gathered and started working with a GNSO Implementation Review Team (IRT)
- Staff will be seeking additional participants form relevant GNSO constituencies (in particular Registries, Registrars and NCSG)
- Work is currently focusing on
 - Drafting Procedures for protections at the top and 2nd levels
 - Gathering IGO Identifiers data (translations as afforded by Policy)
 - Gathering INGO Identifiers and contact data
- Staff will meet with the IRT during ICANN 54
- Policy Effective date (current assumption): 1 February 2017


