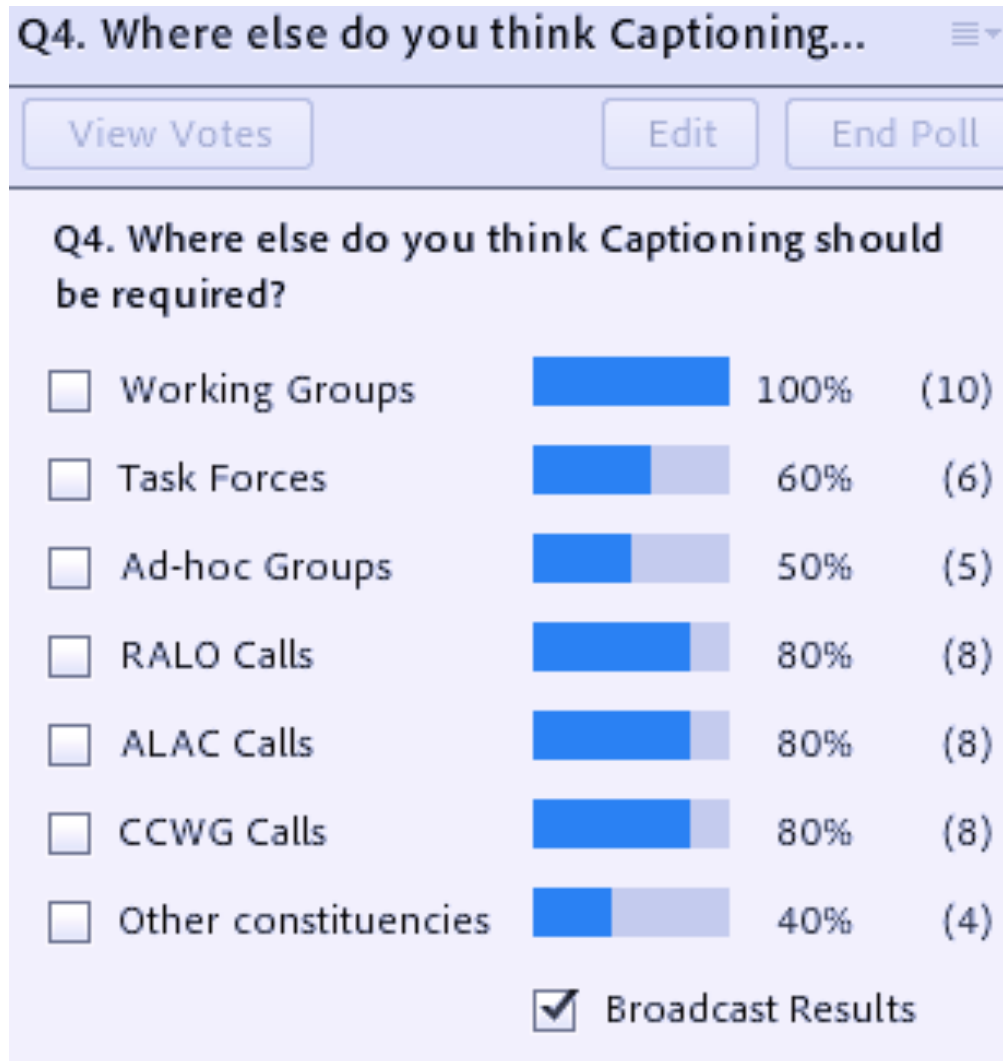


Broadcast Results
