ARIN is one of five Regional Internet Registries (RIRs) responsible for the worldwide technical coordination and management of Internet number resources.



ARIN @ A GLANCE

ARIN is a nonprofit, member-based organization that supports the operation of the Internet. ARIN's core service is the management and distribution of Internet number resources: Internet Protocol (IP) addresses and Autonomous System Numbers (ASNs). ARIN manages these resources within Canada, the United States, and many Caribbean and North Atlantic islands. ARIN also coordinates policy development by the community and advances the Internet through informational outreach.

ARIN serves the following economies:
Anguilla, Antarctica, Antigua and Barbuda, Bahamas, Barbados, Bermuda, Canada, Cayman Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Guadeloupe, Jamaica, Martinique, Montserrat, Saint Barthelemy, Saint Kitts and Nevis, Saint Lucia, St. Pierre and Miquelon, Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, St. Martin, St. Helena, Turks and Caicos Islands, Virgin Islands (British), United States, Puerto Rico, Virgin Islands (US), Bouvet Island, Heard and McDonald Islands
