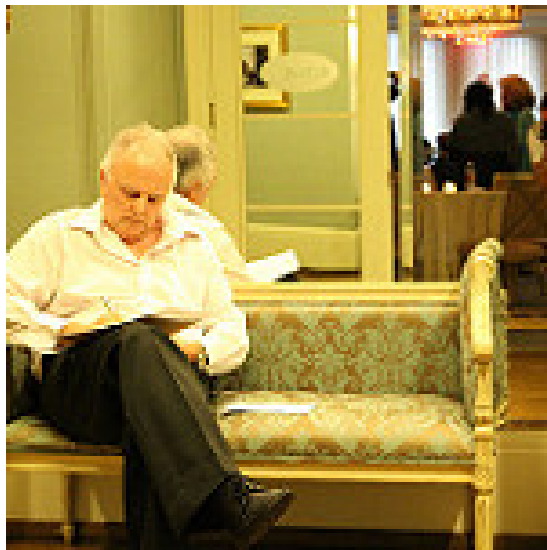

## 2017 NARALO General Assembly

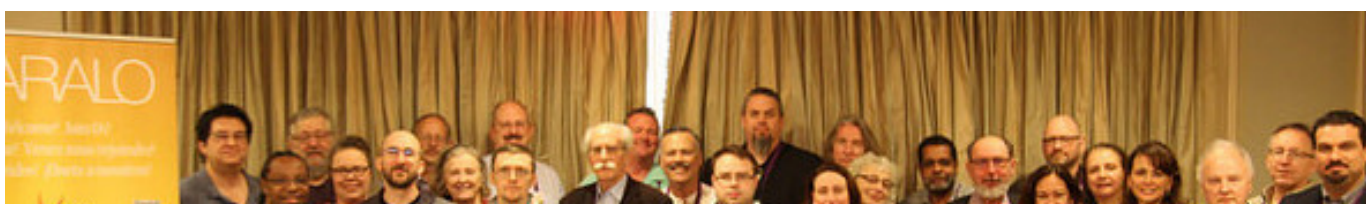

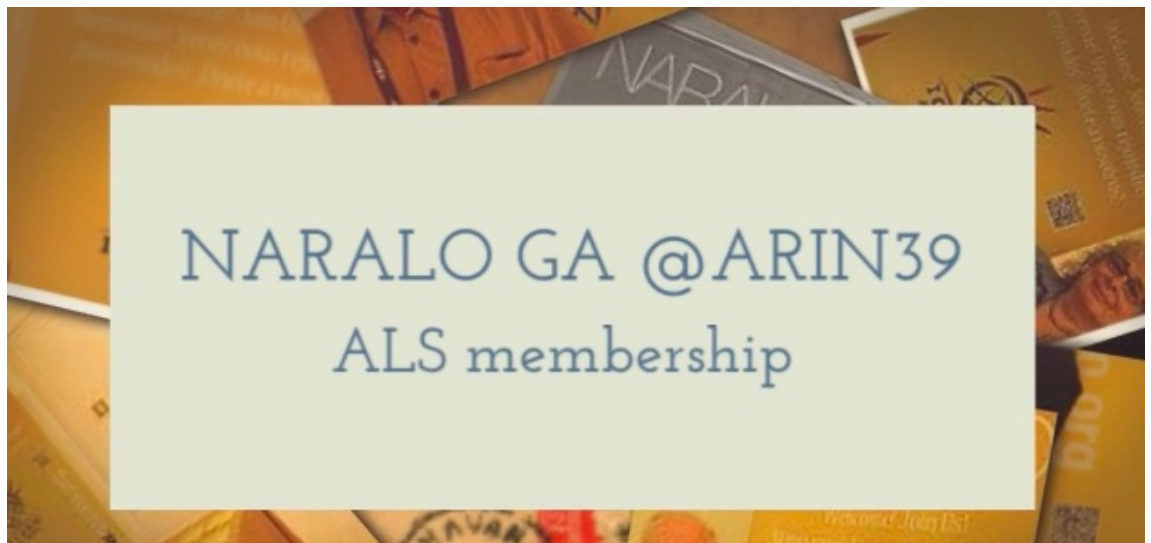
