Decision-Making

a) on split or single decisions within each SO or AC

WP1 recommends to the CCWG that each SO or AC should come to a decision by means of its own processes, and that "split" decisions or delegating decisions to sub-units will not be available.

b) on participating SOs and ACs

Decision rights for the exercise of community powers be granted to the GNSO, ccNSO, ASO, ALAC and GAC. SSAC and RSSAC will be able to advise the other SOs or ACs through the Community Forum. Each SO or AC has the right to participate or not participate in any decision, with their choice not affecting the thresholds established for the exercise of community powers.

c) on the distribution of influence between SOs and ACs

Each of the five SOs and ACs with decision rights have an equality of voice/influence in decisions to exercise community powers.

d) on decision thresholds in the community mechanism

WP1 recommends to the CCWG that the levels of agreement among SOs and ACs in support of exercising a power, and the limits to levels of opposition, be agreed as those set out in the paper from Steve DelBianco updated by Jordan Carter and discussed at this meeting.
