### Introduction to the Outreach & Engagement SC




- Formerly the Outreach SC, a key activity for this committee from 2013
  has been to coordinate and manage its efforts related to the <u>Community</u>
  <u>Regional Outreach Pilot Program (CROPP) for At-Large</u>, in conjunction
  with the <u>ALAC Subcommittee on Finance and Budget</u>.
- In 2015 at ICANN52, the ALAC voted to change the focus of the Outreach SC to also include engagement, hence the name change to the Outreach and Engagement SC.
- Reconstitution of this subcommittee was done soon after ICANN53 by asking RALOs whose members are interested in outreach and engagement activities for their RALO to be in this SC to better coordinate and collaborate with all of At-Large on Outreach and Engagement.
- The first Outreach and Engagement SC call was held on August 3 2015.

- Since ICANN54, the Outreach and Engagement SC has held 9 meetings.
- RALO Members of the Outreach and Engagement SC provided updates to their Outreach Strategic Plans developed as a requirement for the <u>Community Regional Outreach Pilot Program (CROPP)-FY16</u>.

Each RALO's Outreach Strategic Plan should explain its FY16 outreach goals and planned expectations so that any selected CROPP activities can be coordinated with the appropriate ICANN Global Stakeholder Engagement teams. The RALO Strategic Plans includes:

- identification of key outreach events in the region.
- review/analysis of gaps in ALS regional representation.
- specific, measurable outcomes.


- The ALAC Subcommittee on Outreach and Engagement continues to track regional outreach events for possible use by At-Large

Submitted a <u>proposal to the At-Large Finance and Budget SC for access by RALOs for funding of local engagement activities</u>:

"Opportunities exist for At-Large members to do local outreach and engagement about ICANN and ICANN policy related issues. The local activities can include local presentations, brown bag lunch topics, local business persons presentations i.e., Kiwanais, Rotary, Professional Women's University Groups, Chamber of Commerce and more. These local groups at the grassroots are looking for professional speakers on a weekly basis and rely on local experts on various topics. They open up opportunities for speaking engagements at minimum cost.

The ALAC requests that each of the five At-large Regional At-Large Organizations (RALO's) are given access up to \$2,000 each for targeted local discretionary funds to permit the local travel, luncheons, displays, graphic and promotional Facebook/Twitter graphics.

For complete transparency and proper oversight, all RALO budget requests will be reviewed through a process defined once funding is approved."





 Submitted a proposal to the At-Large Finance and Budget SC for ALAC discretion to use allocated travel slots to support active volunteer leaders within At-Large to travel to and attend ICANN meetings

"The ALAC has been allocated travel slots specifically for GNSO and ccNSO liaisons to attend ICANN meetings. Currently these positions have been filled by persons who are already entitled to travel to ICANN Meetings.

The ALAC notes that since this request involves no additional budget allocation, it might be considered one which should be resolved purely within the Constituency Travel processes, and the ALAC agrees. However, since that process has not provided the needed flexibility, the ALAC is following this unusual process."





- Continue to consult with ICANN GSE staff in charge of the ICANN Civil Society engagement efforts. <a href="https://community.icann.org/x/-5FCAw">https://community.icann.org/x/-5FCAw</a>). Our key concerns continue to be:
  - ensuring that the messaging/marketing towards civil society is inclusive towards civil society becoming a member of At-Large, as well as the NCSG
  - o coordination with GSE on possible IG/ICT events that would benefit with an At-Large Presence to assist with outreach.
