

Section 2, Item 1, relating only to the GAC

j. For advice of the GAC that is approved by 97% of GAC members, the Board must achieve two-thirds majority to reject that advice. If such advice were rejected, the GAC and the ICANN Board will then try, in good faith and in a timely and efficient manner, to find a mutually acceptable solution.

j. For advice of the GAC that is opposed by fewer than 3% of GAC members, the Board must achieve two-thirds majority to reject that advice. If such advice were rejected, the GAC and the ICANN Board will then try, in good faith and in a timely and efficient manner, to find a mutually acceptable solution.
