The Contracted Parties House consists of Registries and Registrars whereas the Non-Contracted Parties House includes Commercial Constituencies (Business, Intellectual and ISP Interests) and Non-Commercial Constituencies (NCUP and NPOC). The Nominating Committee Appointees (NPAs) have the voting power.</p> <p>To conclude, the GNSO is the primary body within the ICANN community for developing, recommending changes and modification to gTLDs policies.</p>
