Meeting Notes

The meeting started with reviewing the progress to-date. It was summarized that the WG members had agreed to the charter document in the last call, which has been circulated on the UA Technology WG email list since then.

Further, based on the feedback from the last call, a community wiki pages have been developed for UA technology and other working groups of UASG. The UA Tech WG members were also had to review the documents on UA readiness. In addition, it was suggested to start a common document to start defining the UA readiness. The group was apprised that UA Measurement WG has started this document and the Technology WG could contribute to it. The Tech WG members agreed to contribute directly to this document.

It was shared that some prototype work is being done in Rajasthan on allowing for an IDN domain name and allowing a corresponding email address and supporting this through a content management system. CPanel is also being made UA ready in the process. This can become a case study and can be used to develop training guides, which can be replicated.
