Tom Mackenzie: it's important to explain why it's important, what the issues are

Sam Lanfranco: What does ISOC PIR do around education for .org and .info prospects. Is there scope for collaboration there?

Tom Mackenzie: so as not to get distracted with issues that are not directly within ICANN's remit

Sam Lanfranco: I just reviewed the PIR content on .org and .info. They explain the What and How but say nothing about the Why. That is poor marketing for awareness and engagement on their part. This looks like scope for collaboration.

Agustina Callegari: Thanks Rudi. It was very clear for me.

Tom Mackenzie: sorry - no seems to hear me

Tom Mackenzie: ok

Tom Mackenzie: give me a moment

Joan Kerr: I agree

Tom Mackenzie: there are many issues that NGOs should be aware of: 1) What is ICANN 2) What is the DNS and why does it matter? How can NGOs organize themselves within countries either under using ccTLDs or gTLD

Tom Mackenzie: there are things NGOs can do / need to know individually

Tom Mackenzie: and things they can do collectively within countries or broader regions

Joan Kerr: The point is how ICANN supports the constituencies and NPOC in particular at the showcase

Tom Mackenzie: Would be good to get other organizations like UNESCO - NGO liaison committee

Tom Mackenzie: involved so that they can communicate to their many members about DNS issues

Joan Kerr: Create a campaign on the NPOC discuss and ask the membership to identify groups/ngo's in their area that could work with us

Joan Kerr: Like an inreach for outreach
