Rudi Vansnick:@Mary : observer : calls - no verbal interventions but they can listen into the call ?

Mary Wong:The relevant principles Phil just mentioned are in Section 2.1.4.1

Mary Wong:@Rudi, no - they cannot join the call but can of course listen to the recording and view the transcripts after the call.

VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:@Rudi - Observer :-)

Kathy Kleiman:@Mary and All: People can easily move on and off the Observer list to Membership status.

George Kirikos:Folks can raise their hands to queue up to speak.

Greg Shatan:ICANNs are Icons used in ICANN meetings...

Rudi Vansnick:@Vaibhav : no I'm a member of the group ;)

Mary Wong:@Kathy, yes - and vice versa, especially for a Working Group of some length and intensity.

George Kirikos:Are the "speed up" and "slow down" icons new? (rabbit and turtle) :-)

Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):high jitter

VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:Yes Bad Connection I guess

George Kirikos:Here too. Is Mary on VOIP?

VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:Cant understand

Doug Isenberg:Mary is unintelligible

Volker Greimann:torrenting on the side?

Mary Wong:Sorry

Amr Elsadr:Agree with Mary's suggested plan forward.

Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):Doodle poll ?

George Kirikos:lol Volker

Volker Greimann:the new linux distribution, of course

J. Scott Evans:I would recommend that we post the names to the list for a period of 7 days.

VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:Scott +1

Mary Wong:@Phil, @J Scott - yes
Doug Isenberg:Now Phil's audio is gone
George Kirikos:It'd be better to perhaps have a quick vote here ---- it would save us from 50+ emails of "+1" or "I support"
VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:I also want to understand the format for INternational Inclusion
Greg Shatan:"Cerberus"?
VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:as Policies changing
George Kirikos:(all those emails can be overwhelming)
Doug Isenberg:Working now
Mary Wong:Following that period, assuming no objections, we will send the names to the Council for their confirmation - their next meeting is in May.
VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:around the world
Amr Elsadr:@George: if we make the selection on the call, others who are not on will not be part of the decision. Best to do this on-list IMHO.
Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):let's try Doodle poll instead of e-mails
Darcy Southwell:Agree.
J. Scott Evans:The notice should request ONLY objections or additional proposals to try a quell the deluge of emails.
Greg Shatan:Mary, does that mean that the co-Chairs can't be seated until GNSO Council approves?
Roger Baah:I think thats a good idea
George Kirikos:Not a formal selection, Amr, but just a quick "show of support", which could be overridden on the list, if those who couldn't make it object.

Amr Elsadr:@George: Ok. Gotcha.
Mary Wong:@Greg, typically the WG just proceeds with the new team - on the assumption that if the Council does in fact object, there will then need to be a new selection.
George Kirikos:i.e. something like "48 out of 55" showed support, 6 objected, 1 abstained", etc. and then call for any additional comments/objections; otherwise, proceed to the GNSO. Or agree with J. Scott, just have objections, to save bandwidth on the mailing list.
Mary Wong:@George, we recommend asking for objections - of course, members can always submit those privately to either staff or one of the candidates if they prefer.
VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:There should be a Voting
George Kirikos:(Otherwise, the time of the 50 members here live is somewhat wasted listening passively, when they have an opportunity to be "active" by changing the icon.)
Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):URS in not on the page - is it due being the same phase as UDRP?
VAIBHAV AGGARWAL:@George +1
Jan Janssen:Will the PICDRP also be up for review in Phase 1?
Philip Corwin:URS is phase 1
George Kirikos:URS + TMCH + PICDRP?
Amr Elsadr:PICDRP is not specific to this PDP.
Susan Payne:+1 lars
Mary Wong:Not the PICDRIP, but the Post Delegation DRP (PDDRP)
Amr Elsadr:This PDP is about trademarks, not the public interest commitments in the RA.
Amr Elsadr:PICS will be reviewed in the new gTLD subsequent procedures PDP. I'm assuming the PICDRP will be as well.
Jan Janssen:Thank you for the cle clarification Amr.
Amr Elsadr:No worries.

Susan Payne:just a question about the independent review of the TMCH that Analysis Group is conducting now and how it will inform our work?

George Kirikos:Doodle poll, perhaps, to see which times work best?

Mary Wong:@Susan, staff that support that review have been added to the mailing list, and we anticipate reaching out to the Analysis Group for updates, briefings, interactions etc.

Sonigitu Ekpe:Thank will be great Mary Wong

George Kirikos:Lars: that doesn't necessarily show preferences as to time; e.g. some might want to participate at night, vs. the day (i.e. if it conflicts with their jobs).

Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):rotation of night calls between time zones might be fair

Mary Wong:@George, yes, that is true. Hopefully it helps show the spread for starters. We can do a Doodle poll for more times, though note that we may not end up picking the most popular times as that may not cover the participants in those rgions with fewer members.

George Kirikos:It should be a *weighted* rotation, though, to weight it by preferences. If 90% of people wanted to meet at 11 am (easter), and 10% prefer 6 pm (eastern), it wouldn't be optimal to rotate that 50:50. :-)

George Kirikos:*easter=eastern

Mary Wong:@George, right - that is certainly a good option.

Maxim Alzoba (FAITID):Other continents could be respected too :)

Mary Wong:@Phil, that is correct
