#### Update on Technology Issues



- The TTF has a a <u>Technology Issues wiki page</u> that seeks to track possible technology related issues for raising with ICANN Staff. Two Issues of note:
  - Making Adobe Connect recordings more accessible by exporting Adobe Connect recordings from Flash only recordings to formats like MP4
  - LACRALO mailing list issues



### **Adobe Connect Recordings**



- Adobe Connect recordings require Adobe Flash for playback;
   making such recordings inaccessible to persons with mobile devices
- The experience of playing back Adobe Connect recordings on PCs is very cumbersome compared to playing back of videos on video sharing websites



### **Adobe Connect Recordings**



- Based on the <u>suggestions given by the TTF</u>, ICANN has configured their Adobe Connect account to allow for ICANN staff (at no additional cost) to export Adobe Connect recordings to MP4 format.
- At-Large Staff are currently testing the process to convert Adobe Connect recordings to MP4 and to upload to YouTube.
