EC - What Does It Mean

- EC Empowered Community
- Term used for Designator structure and how community will come together to use powers
- 5 SO/AC "Decisional Participants"
 - ALAC
 - ccNSO
 - GNSO
 - ASO
 - GAC



EC - What Does It Mean

- EC Administration
 - Mechanism for communication of EC decisions
 - Made up of Chairs of decisional participants or their designees
 - No discretion to act outside of EC decisions



EC – What Do SOs/ACs Have To Do?

- Board selection
 - No change to internal processes
 - Notify EC of selection
 - EC must appoint selected persons no discretion




EC – What Do SOs/ACs Have To Do?

- Prepare to Exercise Community Powers
 - SOs/ACs should develop, if not existing yet, internal processes
 - Raising petitions
 - Joining petitions
 - Organize participation in community forum (if coordination desired)
 - Reach decision on exercise of power

- CSC


