- ccNSO Council Statement on the 3rd Draft Proposal:
  - Appreciates efforts
  - Draws attention to the CWG-Stewardship comments
  - Broad provisional support for the direction of travel
  - Strongly recommends need to incorporate CWG-Stewardship requirements
  - Notes that the proposal will need additional refinement taking into account input from, for example, CENTR
- Meeting B: let's wait and see
- Start discussion on ccNSO PDP(s?) on retirement of ccTLDs and on IRP for decisions on delegations, revocation and transfer of ccTLDs
