matthew shears:looking at this document made me go back to the landing page - I think it is still confusing to the complete newcomer to ICANN as to where they should go - ALAC, NCUC, NPOC, etc. That needs to be much more clear as to what the opmtions are so that they know wher to go when approaching this list

Dev Anand Teelucksingh: Agree with Ayden - I don't think there would be need for immediate and expert levels - this is geared for CS orgs not in ICANN to get involved in ICANN

Rudi Vansnick: a nice roadmap would help i think

Miguel Perez Subias AUI Spain: We need to create a simple interface, attractive for normal people and a wiki format not seems too attractive

Gangesh Varma: I understand Ayden. I was thinking on lines of a progression for a newcomer. From one theme/module to another. For example from simple structural understanding of icann to substantive policy issues.

Gangesh Varma: Agree with the need for a more appealing interface, but I think the landing page serves that purpose?

matthew shears: agree Gangesh - needs more structuring

Sam Lanfranco: I could hear him!

Gangesh Varma: I can hear Rudi

matthew shears: i can

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei): yes

Tapani Tarvainen: I can hear you

Rudi Vansnick: i was wondering if there is information on the visitors of the ICANN webiste, to see where they go where they stop visiting the website ...

corinne cath: on getting stuck in the website - it is often so layered that it is difficult to find specific information.

matthew shears:a visual roadmap arrows and boxes would be very helpful for those absolutely new to ICANN

Rudi Vansnick:the wiki is already an stage within the icann global website

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):I think organizing conference by date is not a great idea

Gangesh Varma:@Corinne - yes that is a concern. I think using the idea of organizing by high interest themes/subjects was proposed to address an audience looking for specific areas of concern. I'm not sure though.

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):you have a template for the meeting report?

Miguel Perez Subias AUI Spain:Concerning the calendar we are now working on the next worl information society thay (17th may) and we organize a lot of activities as you can see on this web site www.diadeinternet.org this is a succes case in Spain from 2006 and we can share our metodologie for next editions

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:I think this form of meeting reporting is useful

Daniel K. Nanghaka:I will be at the AIS

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:a calendar like <http://bitly.com/At-Large-Outreach> is useful for future planning

Daniel K. Nanghaka:And we are looking forward to have a Booth

Daniel K. Nanghaka:I agree with Dev, on the calendar

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:A key concern is that the 6 week deadline for ICANN to receive CROPP proposals before such travel

Rudi Vansnick:+1 Dev

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):so how do we find out who is going to a specific meeting ?

Ayden Ferdeline:I believe there is a CROPP report evaluation form

Rudi Vansnick:yes there is

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:so future planning needs to happen well beyond 6 weeks in advance

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):just to get in touch with them and perhaps cooperate?

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:I can also give editing access to other groups to the Outreach calendars

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):So it's not enough to say people. we need to know who is going

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):so that we collaborate

Farzaneh Badii (Badiei):yes

Daniel K. Nanghaka:Yes, we can here

Gangesh Varma:Yes we can. But a lot of background noise.

Ayden Ferdeline:sorry but i am struggling to hear

Eric Evrard:Working on it.

Miguel Perez Subias AUI Spain:much better now

Gangesh Varma:+1 Farzi. Is it possible to have a option to contact the person who would be attending the event. That would make coordination and collaboration easier.

Gangesh Varma:As in an additional column with a contact link*

matthew shears:perhaps this is somethig that we could oreint through ICANN staff - for example if I am going to the WSIS Forum (I am) I would let X on ICANN staff know who would then keep a list of persons and then connect all who are going to a particular non-ICANN ewewnt

Gangesh Varma:@Matt: That certainly sounds like a good idea. Better for ICANN staff to be the contact point rather than multiple attendees.

Rudi Vansnick:we are close to the hour : perhaps an important question : Helsinki meeting : can we have an NCSG outreach event on Monday ?

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:i think so, so ICANN staff will have the civil society events they want to target in advance and then contact the regional persons in the various groups to see if they can attend to do outreach

Dev Anand Teelucksingh:so that the groups can apply for CROPP funding

Gangesh Varma:It would be great if a mail could be sent out with a list of areas that require volunteers. Will certainly help identify areas in which we can contribute or help with.
