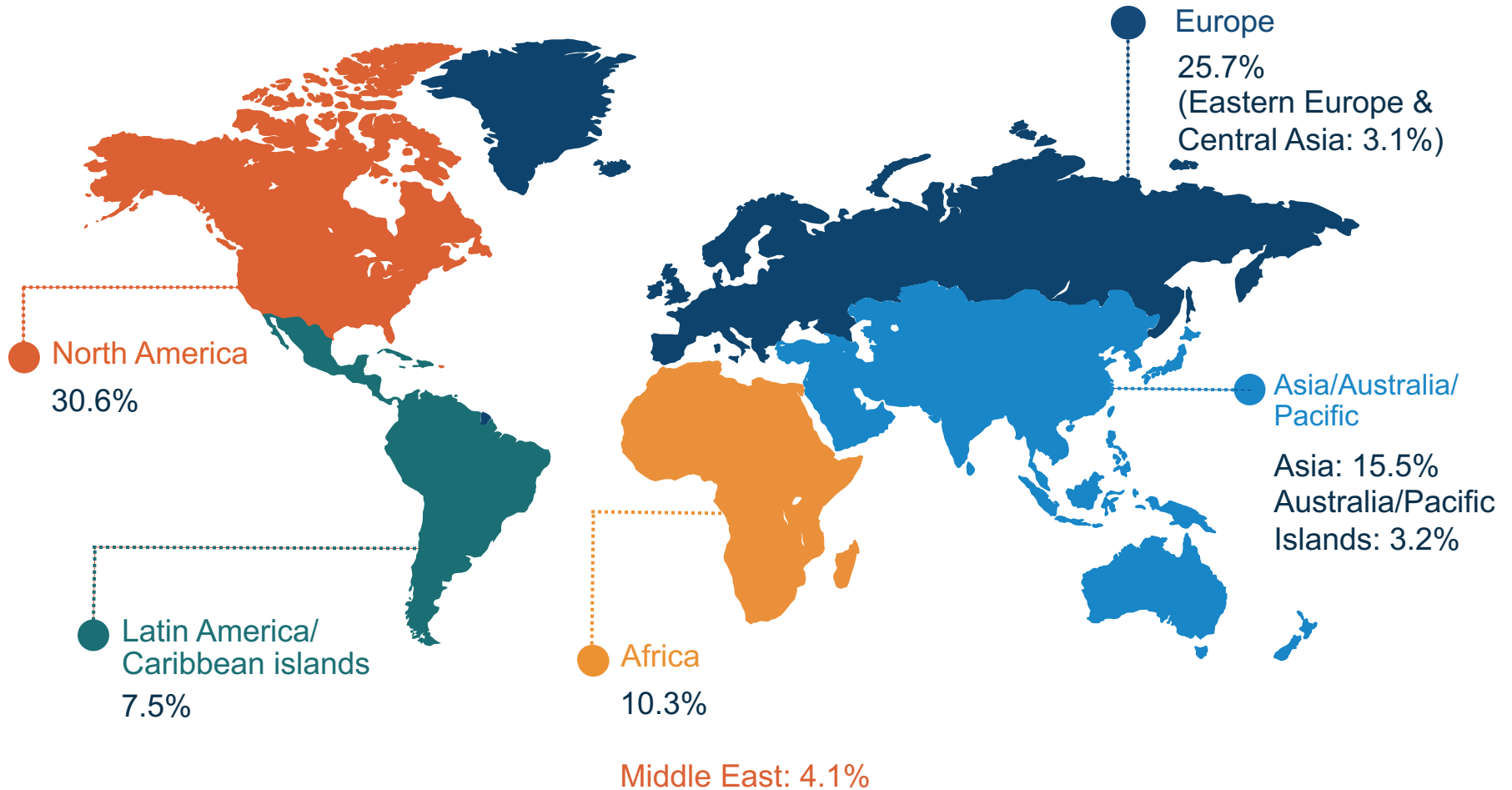

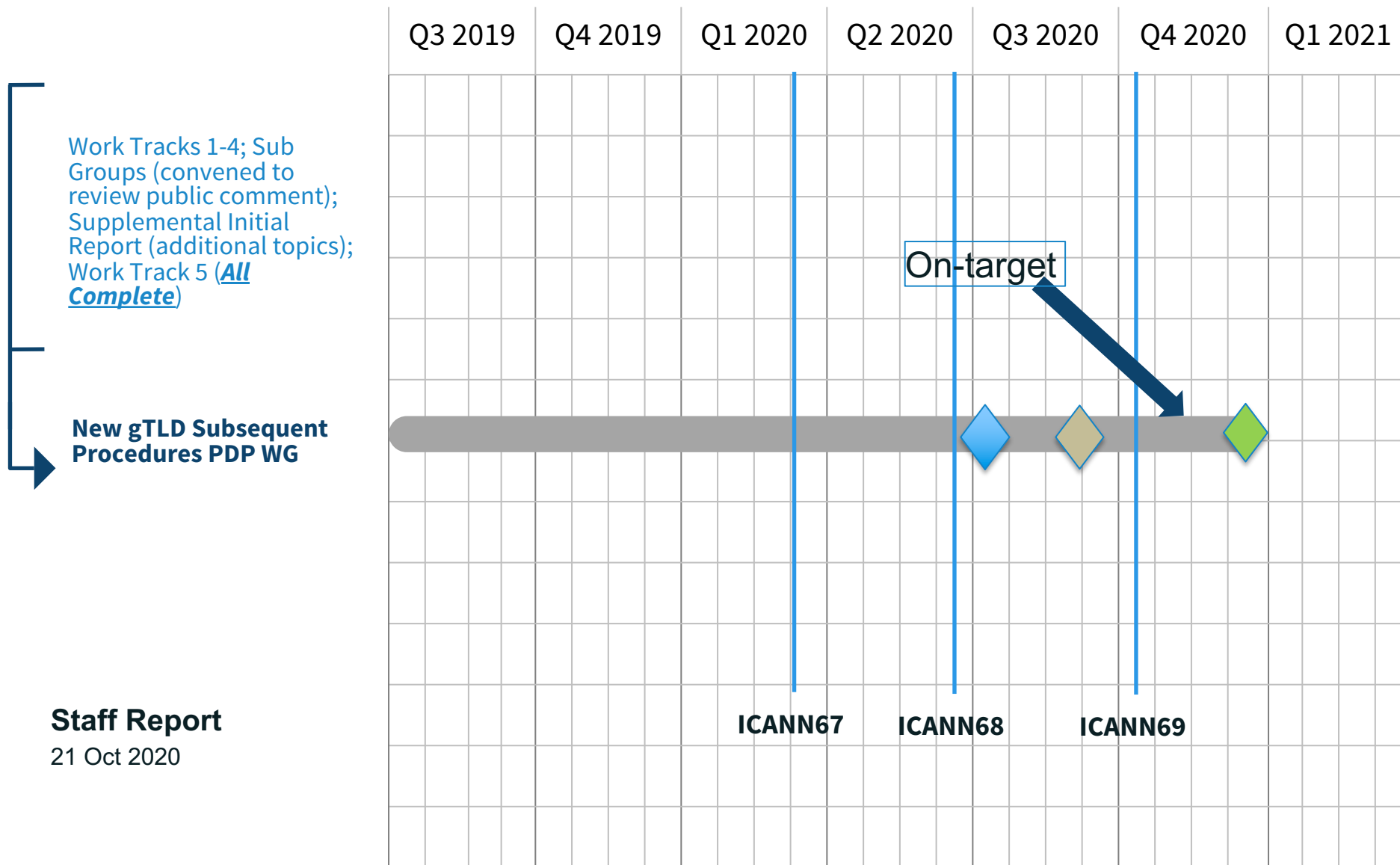

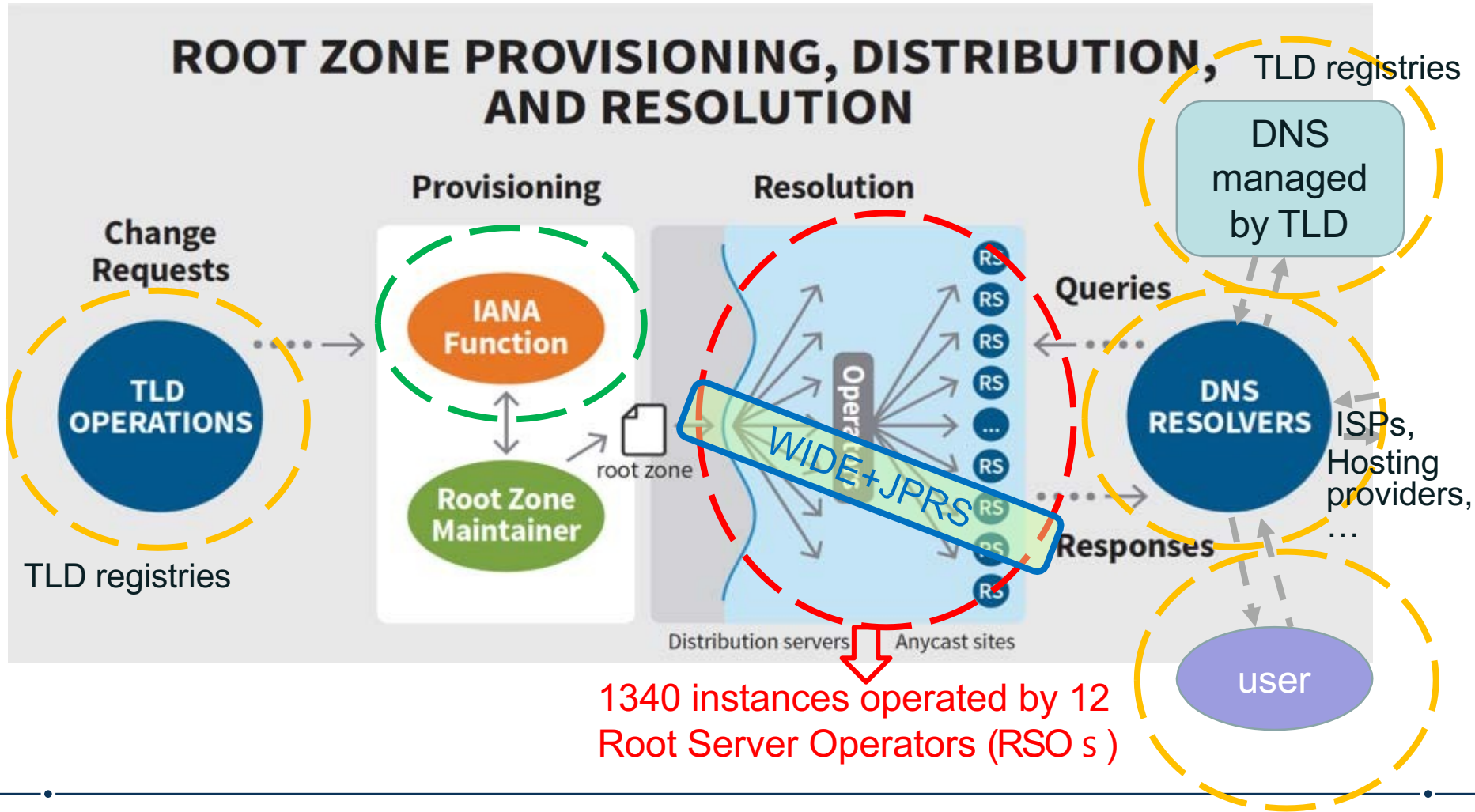

DNS Root Sources



- **RSSAC (Root Server System Advisory Committee)**
 - “Standing” since ICANN establishment
 - advising the ICANN Board and community on matters related to the operation, administration, security, and integrity of the RSS
 - Topics discussed before and during ICANN69
 - Contract framework between each RSO and the overseer
 - How to measure RSS service quality from locations around the world
 - Definition of an rogue RSO
- **RSS GWG (Root Server System Governance Working Group)**
 - Feb. 2020 – Jan. 2022 (planned)
 - core of the community-driven process to develop a governance model for the RSS
 - Topics discussed before and during ICANN69
 - Design of organizational structure to implement RSSAC037 – contractor with RSOs, SAPF composition, ...
 - How to fund RSOs (if financial support needed)

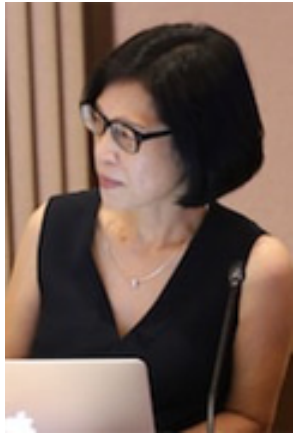

Activities

- A three-week long ICANN Meeting
 - Board Workshop sessions: starting on October 2, ending on October 12, Americas(-ish) hours from 2300h to 0400h (UTC+9)
 - Community Days: from October 13 to 15, European Time
 - Plenary Week: from October 19 to 22, European Time
- European business hours – not a big problem for APAC region, huge problem for Americas, and longer than the previous two

Decisions

- Two-year Extension of CEO Executive Service Agreement
 - <https://www.icann.org/resources/board-material/resolutions-2020-10-07-en#1.a>
 - Now expiring in 2024, making Goran's service eight years long
 - Appreciating his service through tough time with IANA Transition, GDPR, and rise of DNS Abuse discussion
 - Expecting a long-term stability, full coverage of FY21-25 Strategic Plan amongst many
- CCT-RT Review: Pending Recommendations
 - <https://www.icann.org/resources/board-material/resolutions-2020-10-22-en#2.a>
 - 17 recommendations pending since March 2019, 11 out of 17 approved now

- Board Lineup – Chris Disspain to Patricio Poblete (ccNSO appointee)
 - Chris achieved full nine-year service on the Board with countless contributions
 - Now the baton is handed to Patricio, the Chilean Ethos Award winning expert
 - BTW, it is the least number of change of members EVER!
 - Now Akinori is the sole Board Member for Asia Pacific Region!!
- Board Strategic Planning Committee Newly Established
 - Continuous effort for strategy in recent years as the entire board
 - Now with a dedicated Committee, chaired by Matthew Shears
