Eleeza Agopian: ICANN has gTLD zone files but nothing on ccTLDs

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: Does Berry's company collect the ccTLD zone files?

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: berry Cobb

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: might also just be gTLD

Waudou: I agree we treat separately the .brands and the TLDs not live

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: agree

Waudou: .brands

Dejan Djukic: agree too

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: .ly, .tv, etc

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: Jordyn circulated a list of the ones Google thinks are generic

Waudou: Yes, agree with Stand. The open gTLDs should be added to the generic. Perhaps we agree on the list

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: .es

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: .co

Megan Richards: .es ? !

Dejan Djukic: .me, .tk

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: DNPris.es

Megan Richards: : -)

Waudon: We need a definition. I would suggest that open ccTLDs are those open to commercial registrars

Dejan Djukic: google list is fine

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: agree to use Google google list and add to it if we feel strongly

Dejan Djukic: agree

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: there are regional commercial registrars

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: Blacknight sells .ie but it's restricted

Waudon: Ok Noted

Waudon: .uk is an interesting case

Megan Richards: agree with Dejan

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: agree about .eu

Megan Richards: thanks Jordyn !!!

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: if it's a pain to get one, it's not a generic

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: and everything to do with the EU is a pain ;)

Dejan Djukic: it's more cctld than gtld

Dejan Djukic: so yes

Megan Richards: !!! @Jonathan !!

Jonathan Zuck/ACT: we're still going to look at competition from ccTLDs so we're not leaving them out of regional analysis

Stan Besen: Waudo had suggested the following project that has now "disappeared": (1) What proportion of the new gTLDs that signed the Registry Agreement exceeded the 12-month deadline to go live?

Waudo: The format looks fine with me. Perhaps we can adjust accordingly as each project is completed
