Philip Corwin: UDRP is after new gTLD RPMs for two primary reasons-1) to
best coordinate with WG on new gTLD Subsequent procedures, 2) to see if
we make any alterations in the new gTLD RPMs before considering if they
should become Consensus Policies in phase 2
George Kirikos: Wasn't it also a part of the charter of this PDP, that review
of new TLD RPMs came first?
Susan Payne Valideus: ok, sorry i have issues
Marina Lewis: Hi Everyone! I just joined...
Mary Wong: To add to Phil's point, the two phased PDP with the UDRP
occurring in Phase 2 was directed by the GNSO Council and enshrined in
our Charter. The Work Plan just gives current estimates for how long we
believe phase One will take.
Philip Corwin: Yes George, but those are the reasons underlying that Charter

decision

George Kirikos: Susan is typing, so it's pending.

Susan Payne Valideus: just a comment on the timing. I am encouraged that the timing can change as we set about our work - it seems to me that some of these timescales are quite long. PDDRP for example just to take one. Surely it won't take us that long to review given that it has not been used?

Philip Corwin: @Susan--we can adjust the Plan as we go along to reflect the actual time used on a matter

Susan Payne Valideus: noted - thanks J Scott

Philip Corwin: It is scrollable

Petter Rindforth: It is

George Kirikos: It works again.

Steve Levy: You're very welcome. I noticed a missing "a" at the top of the second page in the sentence "a list entitled "List Of Potential Issues..."

VAIBHAV AGGARWAL: :-)

Cyntia King: I'm relatively new to the process, so perhaps this is typical. My question is whether we couldn't shorten the letter?

Cyntia King: We're asking (3) questions in a page-and-a-half long letter.

Renee Reuter: Would it make sense, for Question 2, to list each of the RPMs included in Phase one, with comments following each

Susan Payne Valideus: does the letter include a copy of the charter questions - I assume so?

Mary Wong: @Cyntia, as the SO/AC/SG/C chairs get a lot of emails, it makes sense to have some explanatory/reminder text of the purpose of the letter.

Philip Corwin: @Susan--it has a link to the Charter

Susan Payne Valideus: ah, thanks

Denise Michel: how will this be circulated?

Petter Rindforth: There are a number of links at the beginning, in order to show where to find further information without increasing the number of pages in the outreach letter itself

Philip Corwin: @Denise -- I believe it is sent to the SO and AC heads, and they in turn distribute to SGs and Cs

Cyntia King: @Mary Wong, I understand a brief explanation, frankly, however, the shorter the letter, the more likely recipient's are to read it.

Susan Payne Valideus: or 42 days as that would be a usual public comment

timeperiod - again with the knowledge that we might extend to 60?

Graham Schreiber:<Question> To NeuStar & Phil. NTIA appointed NeuStar to manage .US for Domestic Use, why do they let CentralNic Infringe, Dilute & Blurr the "local" ccTLD of .US by .US.com ?
